

Health Alert November 5, 2009 Pandemic (H1N1) 2009

Current Situation

H1N1 has caused 4820 hospitalizations in California, and 266 deaths. Visits to doctors for ILI are far above normal for this time of year, and are rising rapidly in California as well as nationwide. H1N1 influenza is widespread nationwide.

Updates

- H1N1 vaccine delivery has been uneven statewide, creating frustration for physicians and patients alike.
- City of Berkeley providers who have ordered H1N1through www.CalPanFlu.org should anticipate vaccine delivery by mid-November. We are in touch daily with CDPH in efforts to obtain vaccine for our jurisdiction.

- CDPH is releasing stockpiled N95 respirators for use by health care facilities experiencing shortages. Health care facilities experiencing shortages can request supplies by contacting the Berkeley Public Health Division (see link to guidance below).
