

# Health Advisory December 15, 2010 Pertussis Update

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## Please distribute to all providers in your practice

#### **Current Situation**

On September 29, 2010, Assembly Bill 354, a new law changing California immunization requirements for students entering 7th-12th grades in public and private schools, was passed. The law requires:

• For the 2011-2012 school year, all students entering 7th, 8th, 9th, 10th, 11th or 12th grades must provide proof of an adolescent whooping cough vaccine ("Tdap") before starting school.

This requirement:

- o Begins July 1, 2011
- o Will be met by proof of receiving one dose of Tdap vaccine on or after the 10<sup>th</sup> birthday
- o Applies to all public and private schools
- Does not affect students enrolled in summer school
- For the following school year (2012-13) and subsequent school years, all students entering 7th grade will need proof of a "Tdap" vaccine to start school.

### **Updates**

- Please take every opportunity to review the immunization status of your patients 10 years of age and older, and ensure that they are up to date with Tdap and ready for school entry in 2011.
- Well child visits, sports physicals, and acute care visits, including emergency room visits, are all
  opportunities to update Tdap immunization.
