HEALTH ALERT Novel Corona Virus 2019 – Wuhan Pneumonia Outbreak 2/4/2020

This is a message from the City of Berkeley Public Health Officer.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued a health update on February 1, 2020 about the 2019 Novel Coronavirus (2019-nCov). This CDC HAN Update provides a situational update and guidance that supersedes the January 17, 2020 HAN and supplements the information we released in our January 31, 2020 Health Alert. It adds guidance for clinicians caring for patients with 2019-nCov, guidance for evaluation and testing of patients under investigation (PUIs), and updated infection prevention and control guidance. The CDC also added a Flowchart to Identify and Assess 2019 Novel Coronavirus. Additional resources for clinicians evaluating and managing patients who may have 2019-nCoV, are available online from the CDC
