SUBJECT: Case Closure for Toltec Properties, 2148 Center Street, Berkeley, Alameda County

The City of Berkeley's Toxics Program (COBTP) has submitted a letter dated January 18, 1994 which recommends that the subject site be closed. Regional Board staff have reviewed this letter and a Weiss Associates report on this site (dated January 7, 1994) and concurs with the COBTP's recommendation. Therefore, based on the available information for the above site, it appears that further investigation and/or cleanup of the soil and groundwater pertaining to the former 1,500 gallon underground heating oil storage tank is not necessary. Further work could be required if conditions change or if a water quality threat is discovered at the site.
