RECOMMENDATION

Adopt a Resolution authorizing the City Manager or designee to execute an amendment to Contract No. 32300149 with mySidewalk, Inc. for an additional \$50,618 for a total not to exceed amount of \$207,928, and to extend the contract term end date to April 24, 2027.

FISCAL IMPACTS OF RECOMMENDATION

Funds for the additional scope of work in the amount of \$50,618 will be provided from the Fiscal Year 2026 budgets:

- \$14,693.56 General Fund (Fund 011)
- \$4,913.42 Health Realignment Fund (Fund 156)
- \$31,011.02 One-Time Grant Fund (Fund 336)

CURRENT SITUATION AND ITS EFFECTS

The proposed amendment will extend the contract term and upgrade the current subscription for the mySidewalk web-based data platform. This platform is the central infrastructure for the City's Community Health Assessment (CHA) and Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP).

As the City moves from the planning phase into the implementation phase of the CHIP, continuous access to this platform is required to track Results-Based Accountability (RBA) data.

Without this extension, the Department would lose the technical ability to:

- Fulfill the data monitoring requirements mandated by the California Future of Public Health funding.

- Maintain real-time dashboards that track program outcomes for the Department.

BACKGROUND

In late 2022, the City issued RFP Specification No. 23-11553-C to identify a vendor capable of providing a comprehensive, user-friendly and public facing health data platform. Following a competitive bidding process, mySidewalk, Inc. was selected as the best-qualified vendor due to their ability to integrate local, regional, and national data sets into a singular, interactive interface.

Council originally authorized Contract No. 32300149 on March 14, 2023 (Resolution No. 70,714-N.S.). A subsequent amendment in January 2024 allowed the Health, Housing, and Community Services (HHCS) Department to expand the number of subscriptions and licenses to cover additional divisions.

This contract extension ensures the ongoing support and maintenance of this established digital infrastructure. By continuing this partnership, the City avoids the significant administrative burden and high costs associated with migrating multi-year public health data to a new platform or reverting to manual data tracking methods that lack public accessibility.

ENVIRONMENTAL SUSTAINABILITY AND CLIMATE IMPACTS

There are no identifiable environmental sustainability and climate impact effects or opportunities associated with the action requested in this report.

RATIONALE FOR RECOMMENDATION

This amendment will further allow HHCS staff to engage in continuous improvement efforts driven by program performance data, as well as provide timely and informative communications of the progress of the Community Health Improvement Plan over time.

ALTERNATIVE ACTIONS CONSIDERED

Instead of choosing technological solutions, the City could continue as it has historically, without having Results-Based Accountability data easily accessible to the community. Since protecting public health requires public engagement, staff do not recommend this approach.

CONTRACT AMENDMENT NO. 32300149: MYSIDEWALK, INC FOR HHCS WEB-BASED POPULATION HEALTH DATA PLATFORM

WHEREAS, the City of Berkeley has issued an RFP to obtain a web-based subscription solution to support residents and stakeholders of the City of Berkeley in viewing health data from local, regional, and national sources in an easy-to-understand format and to support the implementation of a Community Health Assessment (CHA) and a Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP); and

WHEREAS, the City conducted RFP Specification No. 23-11553-C with proposals due no later than December 1, 2022, resulting in the selection of mySidewalk, Inc. as the best-qualified vendor, and

WHEREAS, March 14, 2023, Council adopted Resolution No. 70,714-N.S. and the City entered into Contract No. 32300149 with mySidewalk on April 24, 2023, for an amount not to exceed \$128,315 for a term from April 24, 2023, to April 24, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City amended Contract No. 32300149 with mySidewalk on January 30, 2024, by Resolution No. 71,188-N.S. increasing the amount by \$30,000 for a total not to exceed \$158,315; and

WHEREAS, HHCS staff have been satisfied with the performance of mySidewalk, Inc., thus far.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Berkeley that the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute a contract amendment with mySidewalk Inc through April 24, 2027, for an additional \$50,618 for a total not to exceed amount of \$207,928. A record signature copy of said contract and any amendments to be on file with the Office of the City Clerk.
