

Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP)

Purpose is to:

- Provide road-map for how HHCS, the Public Health Division and community will work together to improve the health of the City of Berkeley.
- Engage community organizations and elected officials in the implementation of the CHIP.



GUIDING PRINCIPLES

Four principles emerged during this process. These principles guided the identification of the objectives, strategies, and actions that follow.

1. Balance ambition with feasibility
2. Cultivate Cross-sector work
3. Emphasize prevention
4. Establish a long-term cycle

A thorough look at health, safety, and equity in Berkeley from diverse perspectives





A detailed, realistic response to priorities identified in the assessment







Implementation

- Implementation of the CHIP will occur across 3 phases over the next 3 years
- **Preparation:** December 2025 - July 2026
- **Action:** July 2026 – April 2028
- **Refresh:** April 2028
