1. Participating in a Joint Labor-Management Apprenticeship Program or other state-accredited apprenticeship program, or by making monthly contributions to the California Apprenticeship Council for every hour worked by a construction worker.
2. Making Health Care Expenditures on behalf of each construction worker during periods of employment on the project. Health Care Expenditures may be made to: (1) a health plan in which the construction worker is enrolled at the Health Care Expenditure Rate; (2) a construction worker's health savings account at the Health Care Expenditure Rate; and/or (3) a construction worker as a direct payment at 1.5 times the Health Care Expenditure Rate.

The purpose of the Helping Achieve Responsible Development with Healthcare and Apprenticeship Training Standards ("HARD HATS") Ordinance is to address the shortage of qualified construction workers, rising labor costs, and to refine labor standards in the local construction industry. ORDINANCE NO. 7,861-N.S.

HARD HATS applies to private development projects within City limits consisting of construction, alteration, or demolition of 50,000 square feet or more of floor area which submits its initial application after the effective date of January 1, 2024.

\*The Health Care Expenditure Rate from Jan-Dec 2026 is **\$5.07** and the rate for Cash in Lieu of a Health Care Expenditure is **\$7.61**. These rates are in addition to the Covered Employee's normal rate of pay.

3. Signing and submitting a “Contractor Prequalification Questionnaire” including documented proof of Health Care Expenditures to or on behalf of each construction worker for the 180 consecutive dayperiod prior to the submission of the prequalification documents.
4. At least 7 days before their first day of work, collecting Contractor Prequalification Questionnaires from each subcontractor and documented proof that each subcontractor complied with the Health Care Expenditure and Apprenticeship Requirements of the ordinance.
5. Advising City of Berkeley staff of any new subcontractor added to the project and any change to health care policies or apprenticeship program participation.
6. Paying Health Care Expenditures to employees of subcontractors if those subcontractors fail to do so.
7. Collecting and submitting “Contractor Satisfaction Statements” from each subcontractor within 30 days of the completion of their work.
8. Upon completion of the project, signing and submitting an “Applicant Certification of Compliance” to the City affirming that all contractors on the project satisfied the requirements of the ordinance.
