



NOTICE OF CONSTRUCTION

Allston Permeable Paver Maintenance/Repairs

Anticipated Schedule:

Spring Recess (Phase A): 3/30/2026 to 4/3/2026

Working Hours: 7:30am to 5:00pm, Monday through Friday

Street Closure Hours: 24-7, from 3/30/2026 7:30am to 4/3/2026 5:00pm

Summer Break (Phase B): 6/05/2026 to 6/16/2026 (Tentatively)

Working Hours and Street Closure Hours to be confirmed in a subsequent notice

(Work is scheduled during Berkeley High School recess periods to minimize impacts)

PROJECT BACKGROUND AND SCOPE OF WORK:

As part of the City’s FY 2025 Street Maintenance and Rehabilitation Project, the City of Berkeley will perform maintenance and repair work on the existing permeable pavers along Allston Way between MLK Jr. Way and Milvia Street.

Permeable pavers are a form of green infrastructure designed to manage stormwater runoff. To ensure they continue to function properly, periodic maintenance and repairs are required. This work will include:

- Removing accumulated debris from the openings between pavers to restore drainage capacity, and
- Repairing areas where pavers have become loose to restore structural integrity.

CONSTRUCTION PHASING AND TRAFFIC IMPACTS:


Construction will be **limited to the roadway** and will **not impact pedestrian sidewalks**. Temporary **“No Parking”** restrictions may be required within the work area and will be posted **at least 72 hours in advance**.

To maintain access to the mid-block parking area at **2180 Milvia Street**, construction will be completed in **two phases—Phase B will be confirmed in a second notice to follow:**

- **Phase A:** Work will occur on the **eastern portion of Allston Way**, with 2180 Milvia St parking lot access via **MLK Jr. Way**.
- **Phase B:** Work will occur on the **western portion of Allston Way**, with 2180 Milvia St parking lot access via **Milvia Street**.

Driveway access behind 2180 Milvia St will be maintained at all times. The diagram below provides a general illustration of the traffic flow around the work area.
