



RECOGNIZING THE UNITED NATIONS 80th ANNIVERSARY


WHEREAS, 2025 marks the 80th anniversary of the founding of the United Nations since the Charter was historically signed in San Francisco on June 26, 1945; and

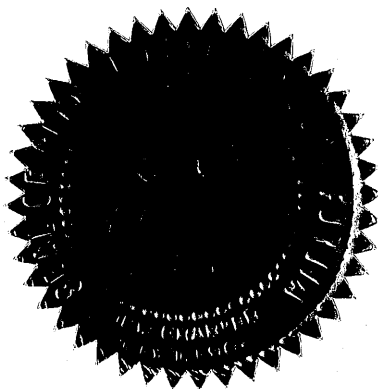
WHEREAS, the United Nations remains a bedrock of values and principles of the government and residents of the United States, California and the city of Berkeley; and
