#### Purpose of BMC Amendments

- Reflect State regulations
- Clarify operational and development standards for all cannabis businesses
- Allow Retail Nursery Microbusinesses
- Allow Temporary Cannabis Events
- Protect youth

#### **BMC Amendments**

- Add 12.21 General Regulations
- Amend 12.22 Operating Standards
- Add 20.40 Advertising Regulations
- Amend 23C.25 Cannabis Uses
- Amend Sub-Titles 23E and 23F Zoning Ordinance provisions and definitions
- Remove Chapters 12.23, 12.25, 12.27, and Section 23E.16.070

#### **General Regulations (BMC 12.21)**

- Adds and amends definitions
- All businesses subject to requirements for operations, security, neighborhood compatibility, records
- Includes age requirements, odor control plans, guard and camera requirements, on-site manager, prohibition of tobacco and alcohol

#### Operating Standards (BMC 12.22)

- Establishes specific regulations for each business type, such as:
- Operating permits
  - Notices at retailers
  - Delivery requirements
- Prohibits Residential Collectives
- Allows Retail Nurseries and Temporary Events

### Advertising (BMC 20.40)


- Creates new advertising regulations for cannabis businesses
- Based on tobacco product advertising chapter
- Prohibits cannabis product advertising in any publicly visible location.
- Limits permitted business signs


## <u>Development Standards</u> (Zoning Ordinance)


- Creates development standards for all cannabis business types
  - Buffers and quotas for Storefront Retailers
  - Quota for major cannabis facilities
- Creates new section for Microbusinesses
  - Allow up to two Retail Nursery Microbusinesses through conversion of existing nurseries

#### Issues requiring Council action

- Guards at non-Storefront Retail establishments
- Consumption of cannabis at Storefront Retailers
- Delivery requirements
- Retail quotas
- Discretion for Retail Nurseries
- Retail buffers

- Provide direction regarding alternatives included in the ordinance
- Adopt new ordinance language
