

RESOLUTION NO. 68,802-N.S.

AUTHORIZING \$5.3 MILLION IN MEASURE T1 PHASE 2 FUNDS TO BE USED TO COMPLETE MEASURE T1 PHASE 1 PROJECTS

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2017, Council approved \$37.365 million in projects for Measure T1 Phase 1; and

WHEREAS, on January 23, 2018, Council approved Resolution 68,290-N.S., allocating \$2 million from T1's Phase 1 for Major Renovations of the City of Berkeley's Adult Mental Health Clinic located at 2640 Martin Luther King Jr. Way; and

WHEREAS, in November 2017, \$35 million in bonds were sold for Measure T1 Phase 1; and

WHEREAS, due to the cost of approved projects exceeding bond proceeds, an increase in energy upgrades included in the facility projects, and soaring escalation there is an estimated funding gap of \$5.3 million in Measure T1 Phase; and

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2016, Council adopted Resolution 67,781-N.S., which allowed the General Fund to advance T1 projects and be reimbursed later when T1 bond dollars are available; and

WHEREAS, there is \$5.3 million available in the City's General Fund for Measure T1 Phase 1 between FY 19 to FY 21.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Berkeley that funding in the amount of \$5.3 million from General Fund be used for Measure T1 Phase 1. The General Fund will be reimbursed once Measure T1 Phase 2 bond proceeds are received.
