### **Discussion and Possible Action: Public Facilities Improvement Program - Insight Housing and Larkin Street Youth Services**

Action: M/S/C (Haycox/Palmatier) to recommend adoption of Staff's recommendation to:

1. Approve substantial amendments to the federal Program Years (PY) 2018, 2019, 2020, and 2021 Annual Action Plans (AAP), which propose a total reallocation of \$478,500 of Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds from the Senior Disabled (Home) Loan Rehabilitation Program (SDLRP) to the Public Facility Improvement Program;
2. Allocate \$450,000 of the reallocated funds to Insight Housing's (IH) existing public facility rehabilitation project at 2140 Dwight Way;
3. And allocate \$52,775 to Larkin Street Youth Services' (LSYS) existing public facility rehabilitation project at 3404 King St (\$28,500 from above reallocated funds and \$24,275 from available PY 2024 funds);
4. and to draw City Council's attention to the necessity of the leveraged funds for Insight Housing in order to ensure that the project moves forward.
