Re: 2024-2025 Sports Field Closures for Maintenance

The Parks, Recreation and Waterfront Department annually closes grass turf sports fields throughout Berkeley for maintenance. This maintenance includes replacing irrigation heads and lines, aeration, over-seeding and the addition of amendment, top soil or sand. The following grass fields will be closed from Monday, November 25, 2024 until Monday, February 24, 2025.

- Codornices Park Softball
- Glendale La Loma Park Softball
- Grove Park Softball
- Harrison Park Soccer (2)
- Ohlone Park Soccer and Softball (2)
- San Pablo Park Baseball, Softball and Soccer (3)
- Tom Bates Soccer (2) and Softball (1)
- Thousand Oaks Turf Area

Additional partial closures include:

1. James Kenney Softball.
This field will be closed from Friday, December 22, 2024 to Monday January 6, 2025. This field is largely staying open during the winter because it is being used by the relocated Longfellow Middle School.
2. Cedar Rose Turf Area.
This area will be closed Monday January 6, 2024 until Monday, February 24, 2025. This abbreviated closure allows for extended community use.

Sports field reopening dates may vary depending on weather conditions.
