DRC –

- Commissioner Thompson has been elected as the new ZAB representative to the DRC.
- The DRC has elected Commissioner Gaffney as the Chair, and Commissioner Muszynski as the Vice-Chair.
- The DRC conducted a Preliminary Design Review with favorable recommendations to ZAB on the Use Permit Modification for the Berkeley Humane project at 2700 Ninth Street. The facility has been redesigned and on-site parking has been removed in this modification.
- The DRC conducted a Preliminary Design Review with favorable recommendations to ZAB on the Use Permit Modification for 2147 San Pablo Avenue. The modification is to increase Group Living Accommodation, increase the number of Very Low-Income units, increase height, remove parking spaces and make minor design changes.
- The DRC conducted a Preliminary Design Review for an eight-story mixed-use residential building at 2655 Shattuck Avenue with favorable recommendations to ZAB with a condition and recommendations for the Final Design Review.
