Subject: Applications for the SAFE STREETS Citizens Oversight Committee

Measure FF, also known as the Sustainable and Accountable Funding for Equitable Street Transformation, Revitalization, Enhancements, and Essential Traffic Safety (SAFE STREETS) Initiative, was passed by voters on November 5, 2024, and adopted as Ordinance 7,952-N.S. on December 10, 2024. The measure requires the establishment of the SAFE STREETS Citizen Oversight Committee (SSCOC) in Section 7.11.040.

The membership of the SSCOC consists of seven members as follows: two members of the Transportation and Infrastructure Commission, one member of the Environment and Climate Commission, and four members of the public appointed by the Council as a whole. The members of the public are required to have a background in civil engineering, transportation engineering, infrastructure program management, or the implementation of municipal bond or tax measures. The Council will consider an amendment to the measure on April 29, 2025 to add ADA experience to the list of required criteria. If approved, that amendment will be effective in late June.

Following Council approval of the SSCOC implementing resolution on March 18, 2024, an application period opened for the four public members. The City received 14 applications by the April 15 deadline. All of the applications received are attached for review.

The City Clerk will submit an agenda item for the May 20, 2025 meeting for the Council to take formal action to appoint the four public members from the pool of applicants.



Brief Background Description for David L. Goldin A.I.A.



David L. Goldin A.I.A. served as the Chief Facilities Officer for the San Francisco Unified School District from 2004 to 2018. In this capacity Mr. Goldin directed 10 operational departments and a staff of 650 persons, including the \$2.4 billion school facility construction bond program at over 140 district school sites. In addition, he directed the district's custodial, facility maintenance, transportation, environmental health, emergency planning, real estate, facility rental permitting and energy sustainability departments with annual operating budgets of over \$75 million, excluding construction. Mr. Goldin was a member of the Superintendent's Cabinet and an active participant in the development and implementation of the District's strategic planning to improve academic achievement.

Mr. Goldin is twice a graduate of the University of California at Berkeley, studied architecture and planning in Sweden and graduated Phi Beta Kappa. He is a registered California architect and licensed general building contractor. His professional experience includes a diverse background of experience including the design of cities in Saudi Arabia and Indonesia, educational, institutional and religious facilities and the management and construction of public and private schools in California. In addition, he served on the Board of Directors and as Board Chair of Hamilton Families in San Francisco, a non-profit dedicated to eliminating family and child homelessness in the San Francisco Bay Area and is a Board Trustee of the San Francisco Campus for Jewish Living, one of the Bay Area's largest senior care providers.

Mr. Goldin is married to an architect, is the son of an architect and has two children, neither of whom chose to become architects. In addition to traveling abroad whenever he can, David can be found doing Tai Chi, hiking around the Bay area and happily paddling in his bright yellow kayak.

For the last four years I have served as a Deputy City Administrator in the City and County of San Francisco. One of the most significant programs I oversee is the Office of Resilience and Capital Planning which produces the City's ten-year capital plan, General Obligation Bond Measures and the City's proposed annual capital budget. Streets are one of the largest recipients of capital dollars in the City, with a program that encompasses street resurfacing, sidewalk and curb ramp programs, and bicycle and pedestrian safety projects.

The implementation of San Francisco's capital plan has resulted in the funding of numerous complete street projects (with safety and environmental benefits) and allowed the City to improve its Pavement Condition Index from a score of 63 (Fair) in 2010 to a score of 75 (Good) in 2024. (Berkeley's PCI score in 2023 was 56, categorized as "at risk".)

Prior to working in the City Administrator's Office I was the Manager of Finance, Budget and Performance for the San Francisco Department of Public Work where I worked closely with our engineering division and championed funding for these programs. In 2011 I helped spearhead a \$248 million Road Repaving and Street Safety General Obligation Bond which was approved by the voters. I was responsible for reporting on bond expenditures to the City's Capital Planning Committee and the Citizen's General Obligation Bond Oversight Committee. This initiative had similar goals to Berkeley's measure FF and I believe the implementation of the projects helped strengthen San Franciscan's trust in the City's ability to deliver needed services.

As the parent of two bicycle riders at Berkeley High School, and pedestrian, cyclist and driver in my home town I am excited to contribute my expertise to the Safe Streets Citizen's Oversight Committee.

I have a master's degree in City and Regional Planning with a focus in transportation planning and policy.

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
