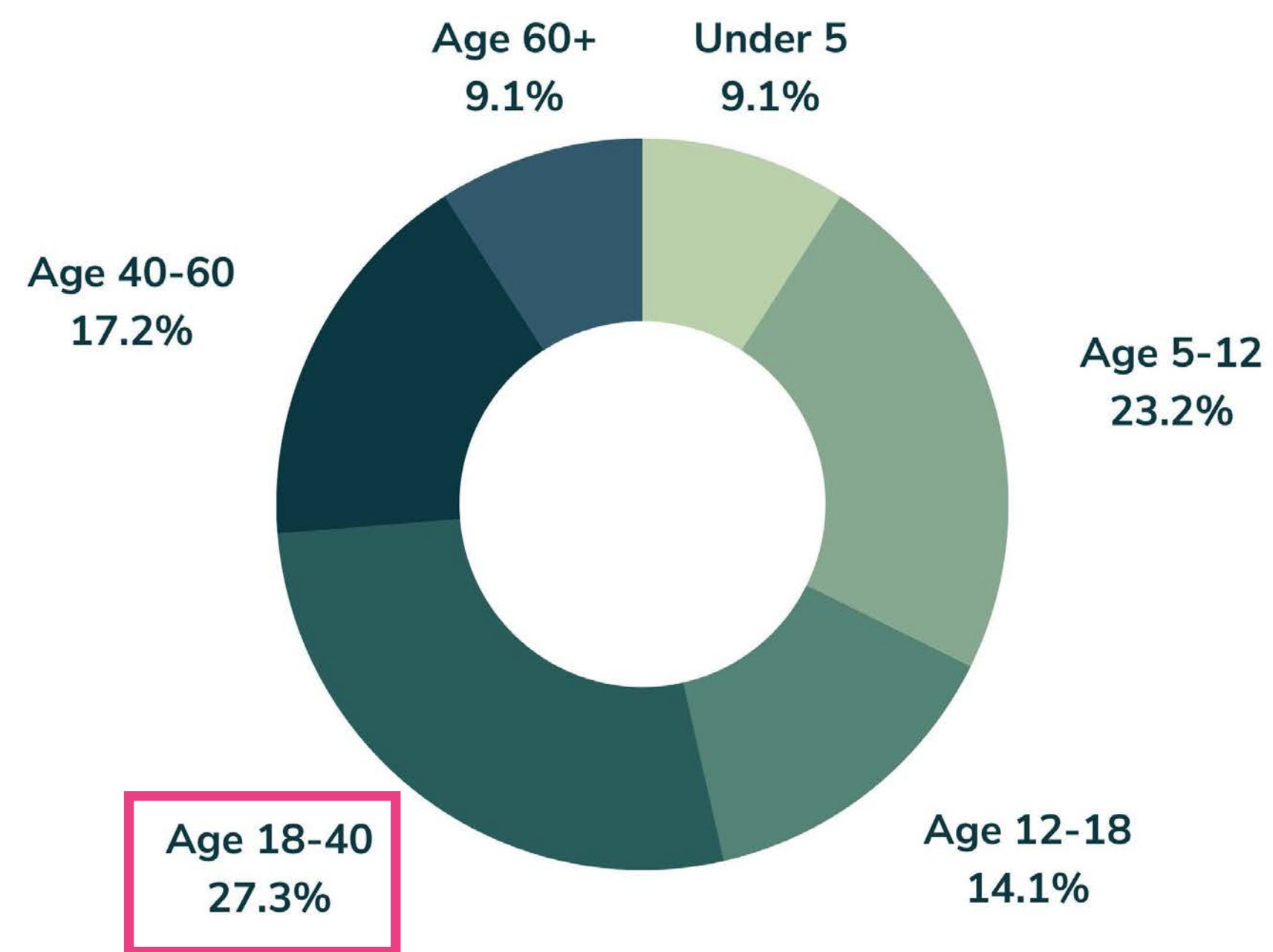

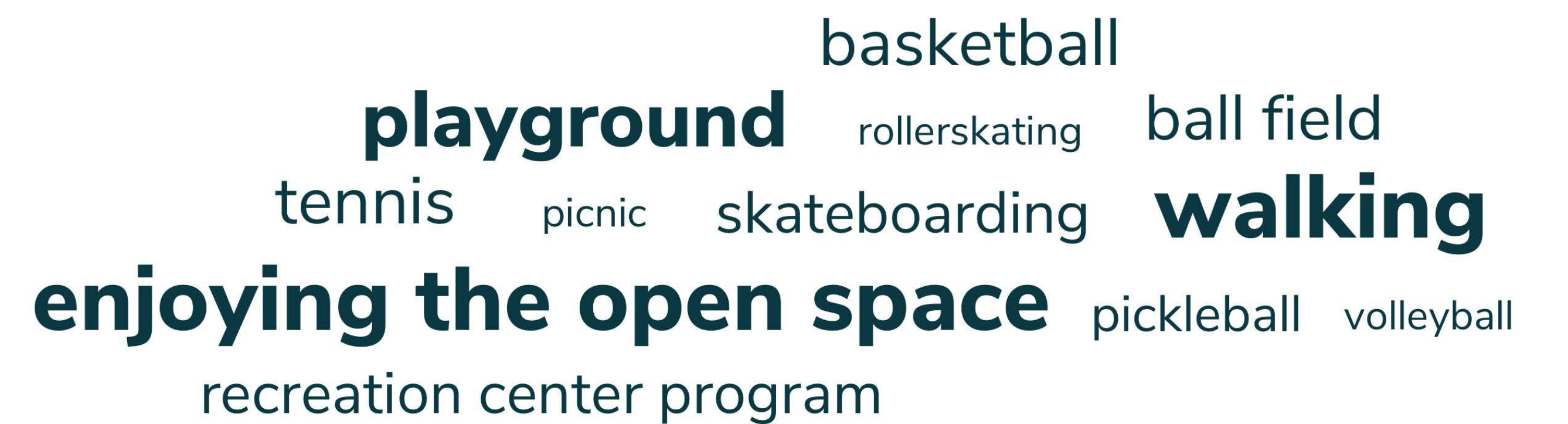

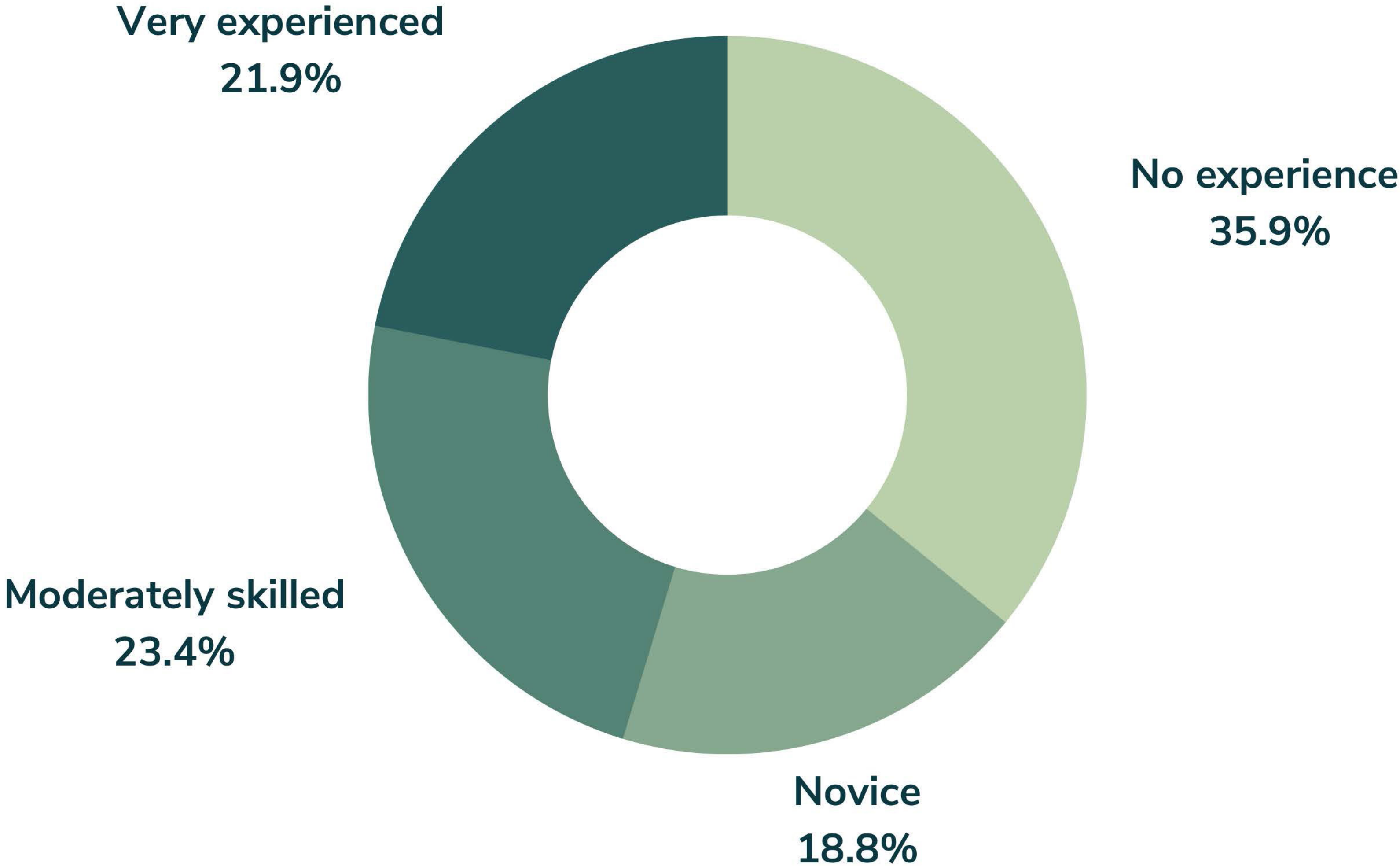

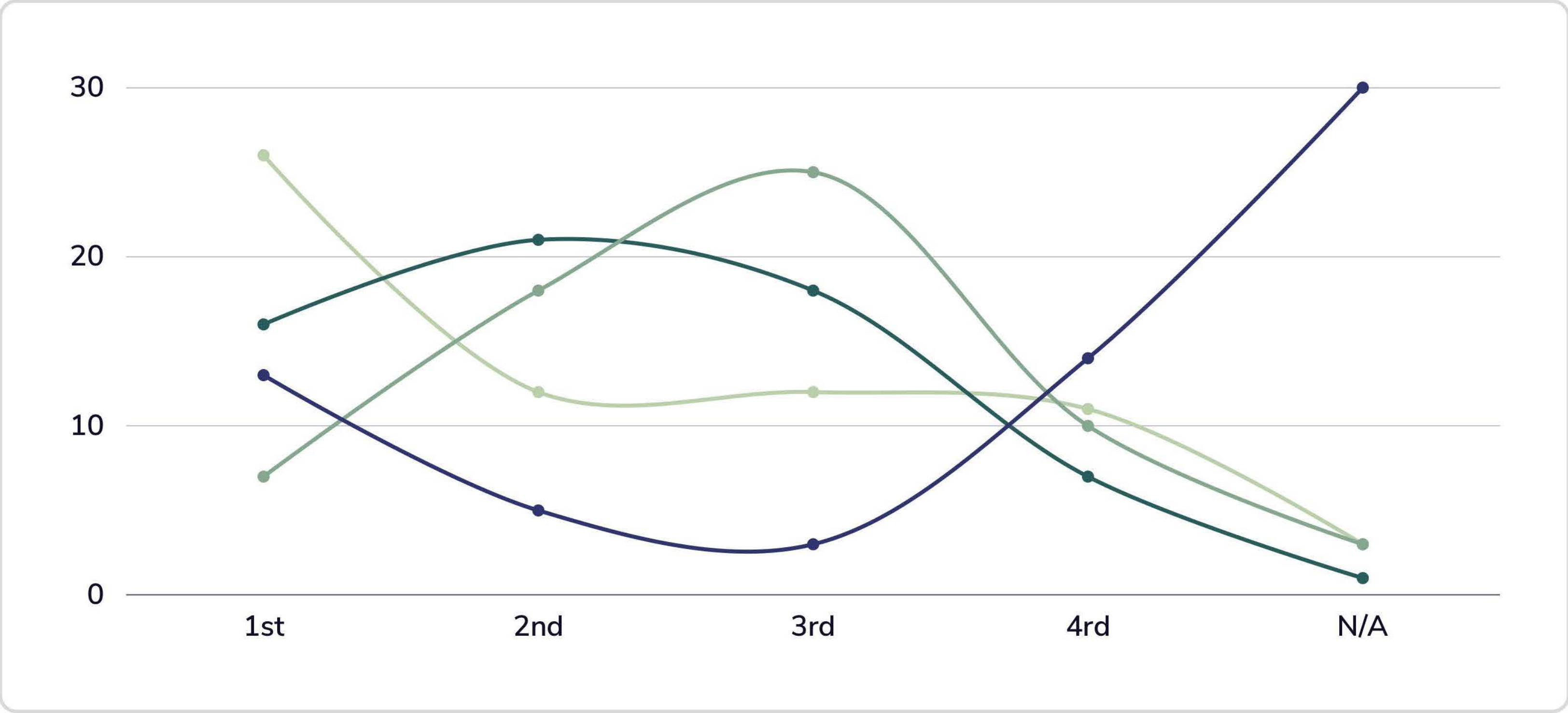

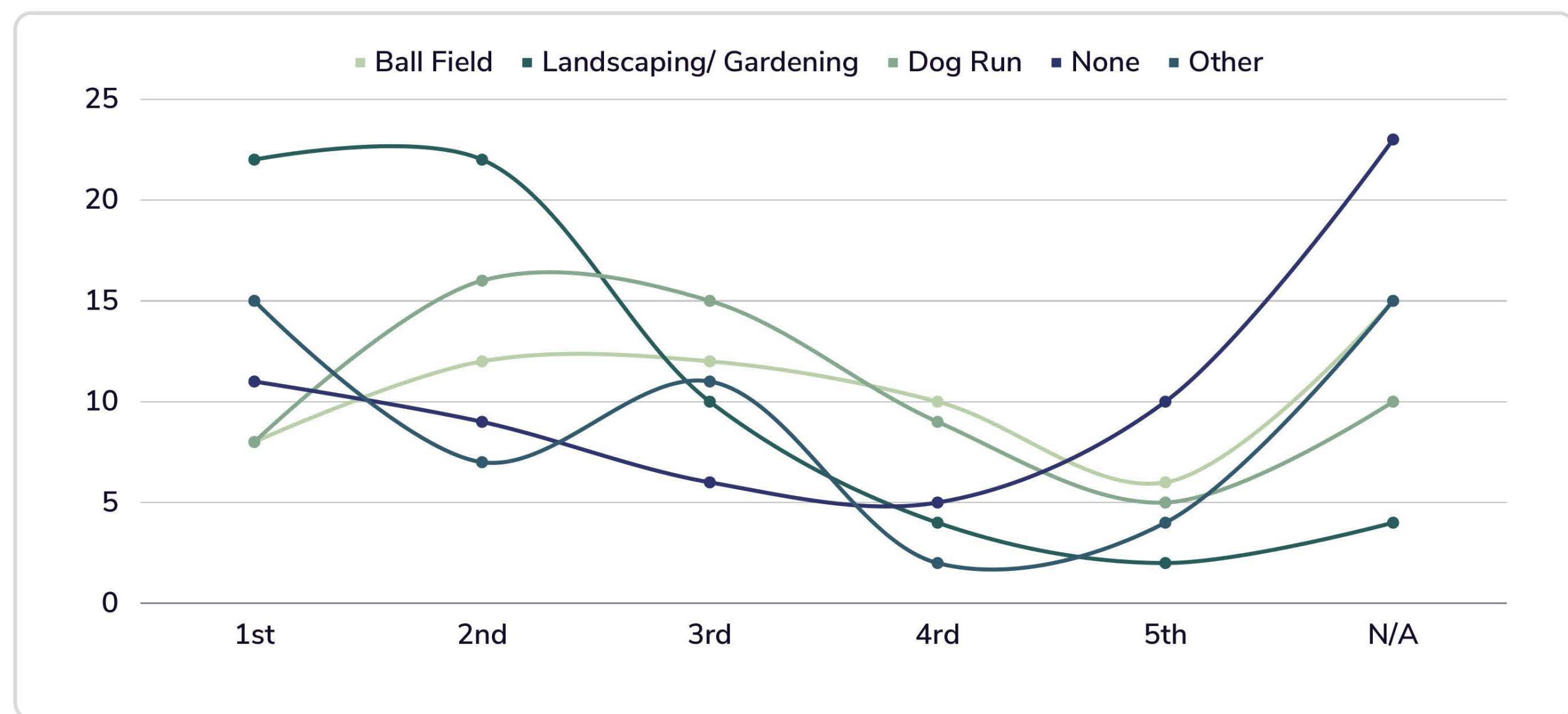

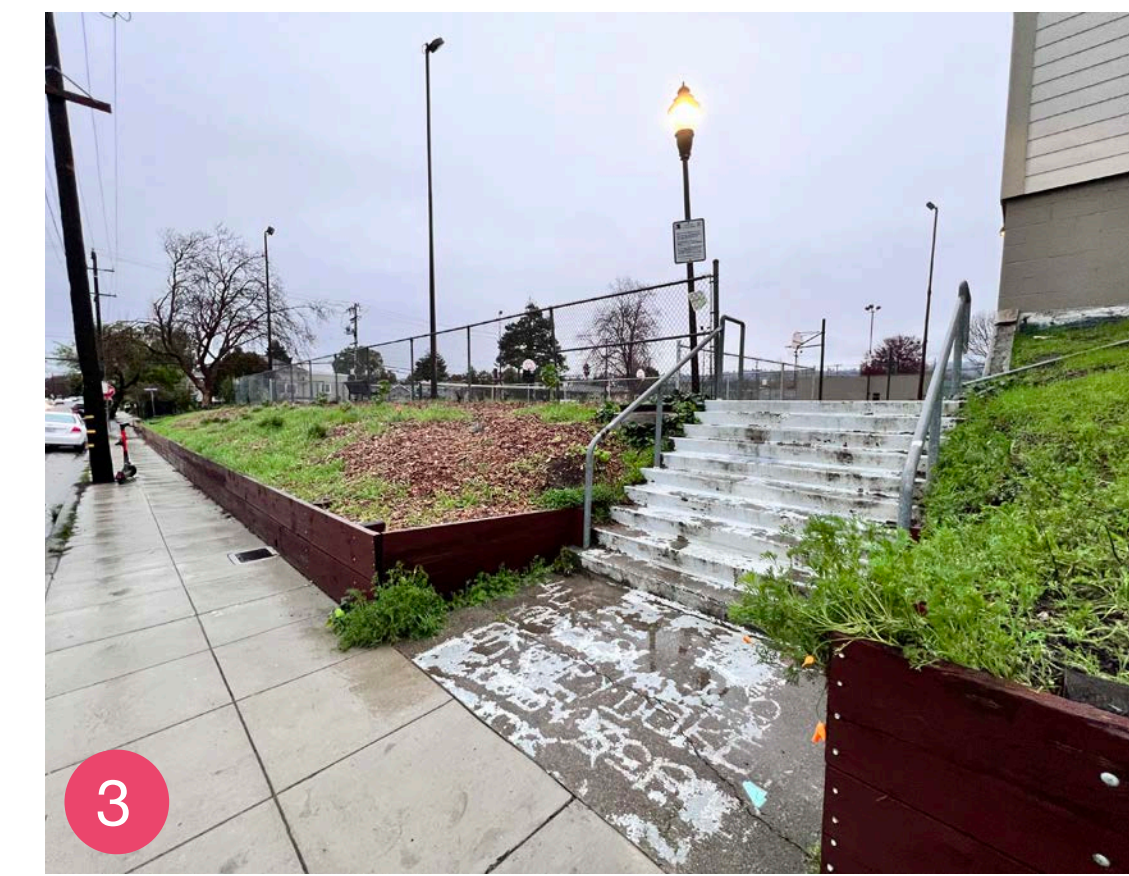
EXISTING CONDITIONS - OVERALL PARK

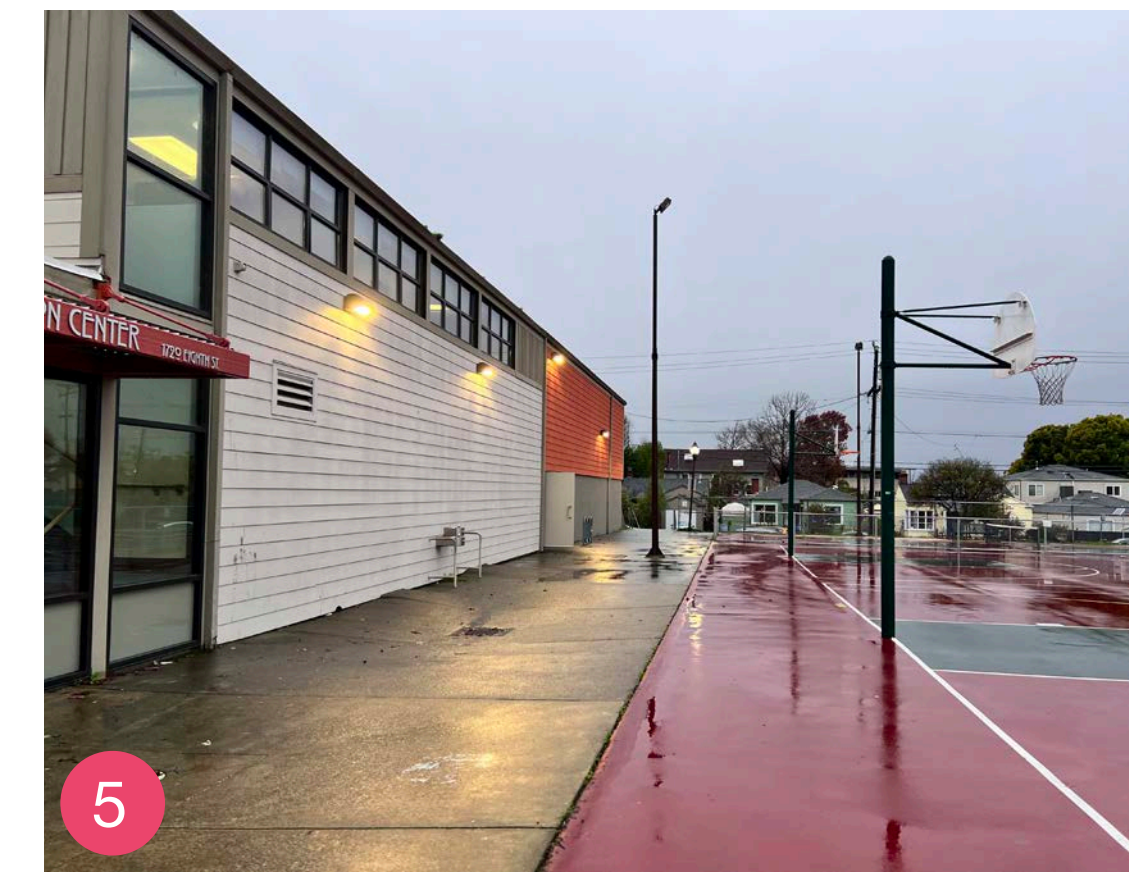

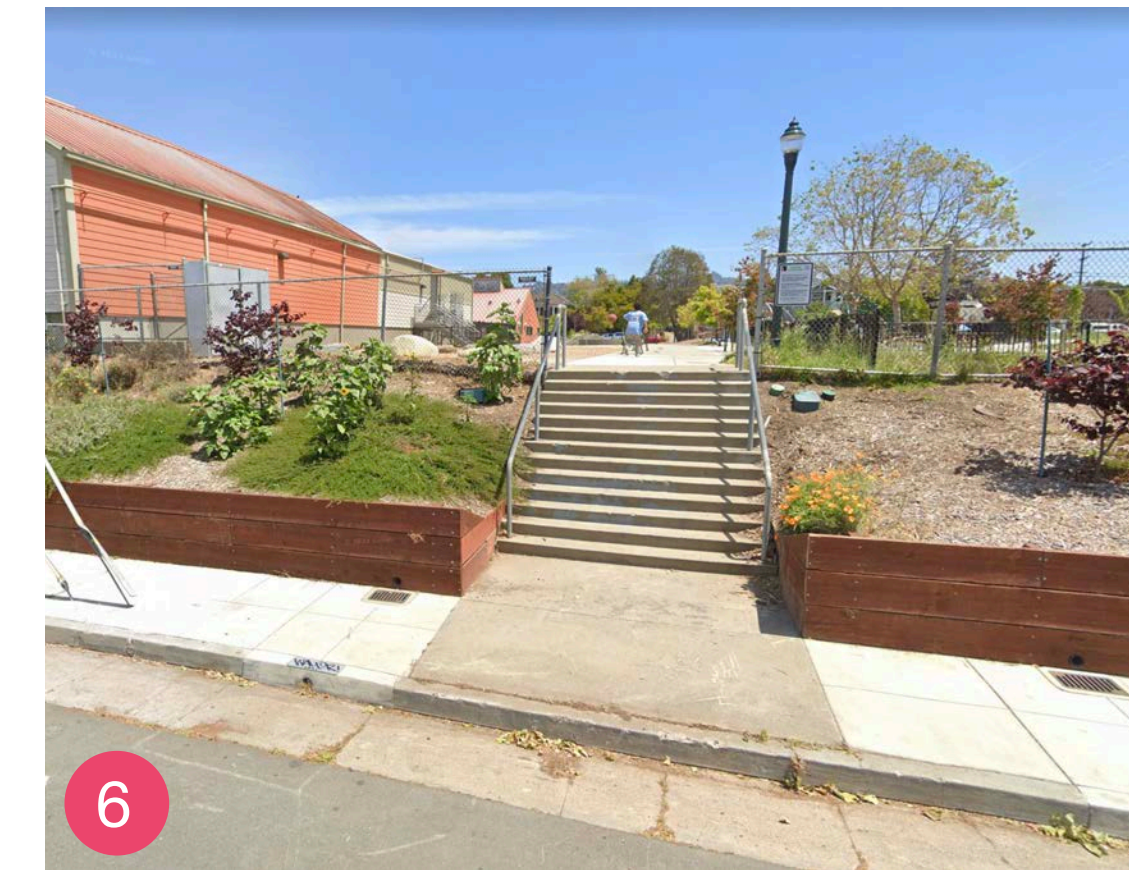

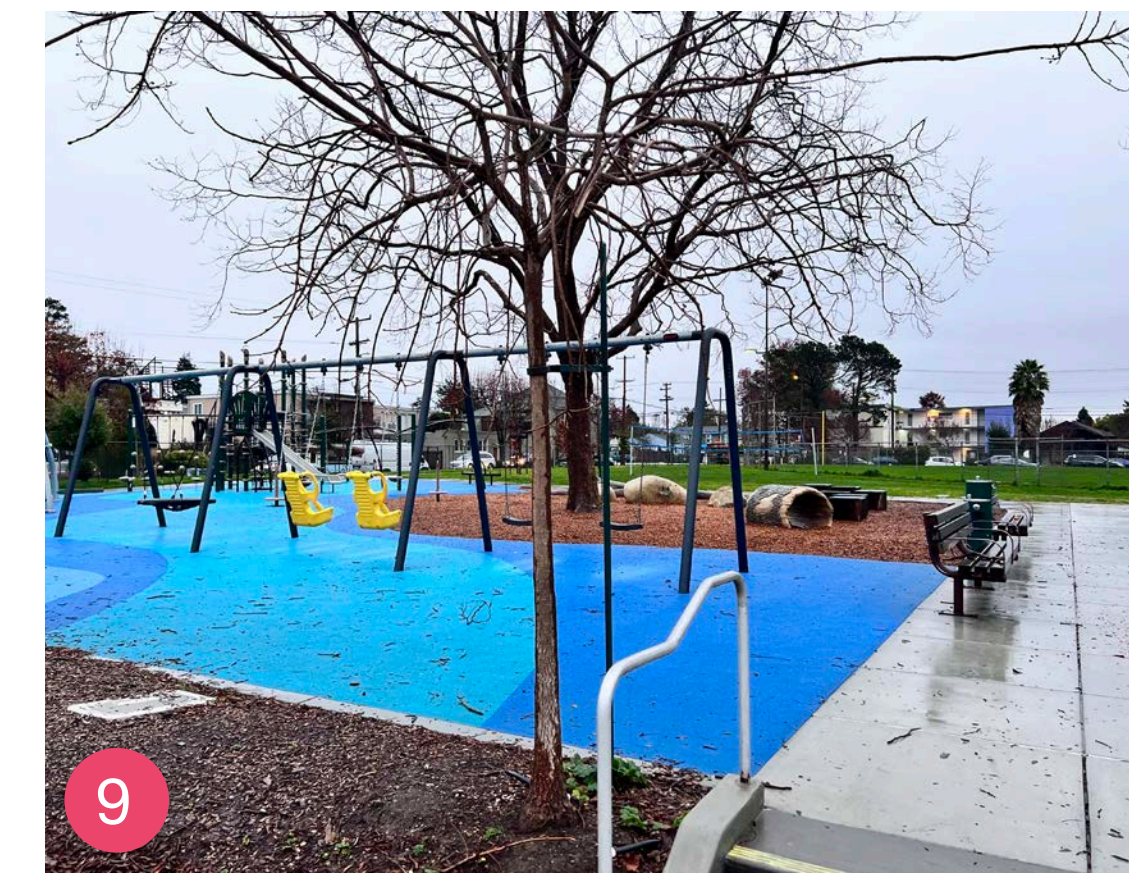

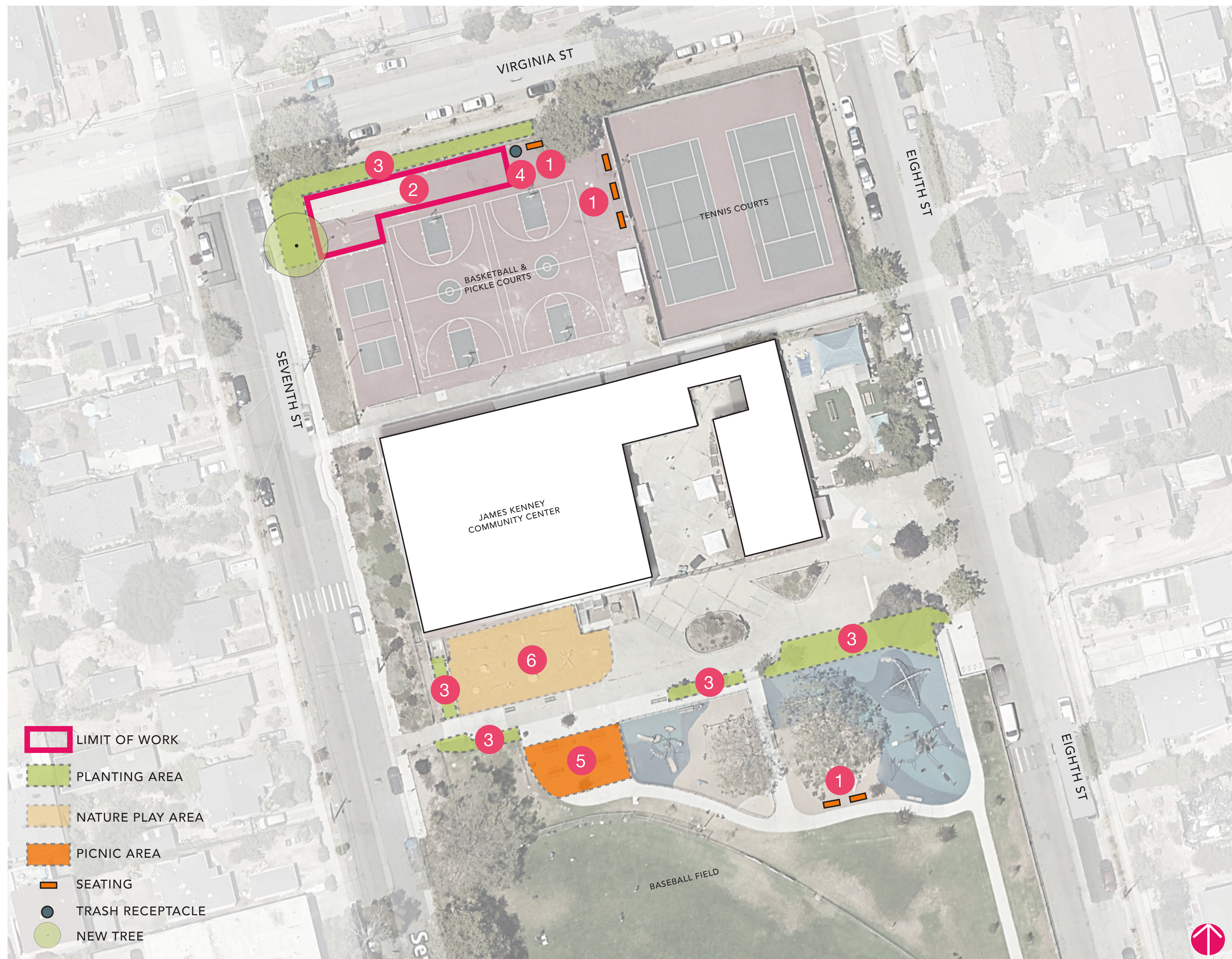
