The Engineer's estimate for the work is \$800,000.

3. California Contractor License Classification required: A (General Engineering).
4. Location: The location of the Work described in these Specifications is shown in the Plans. In general, the Work of this project is on Sacramento Street, from Oregon Street to Fairview Street.
5. Time of Work and Liquidated Damages: The City anticipates an approximately three-and-one-half month period from the issuance of Notice of Award to the issuance of the Notice to Proceed. The Contractor shall commence work of construction under the contract within fifteen (15) working days following the effective date of the Notice to Proceed. The Notice to Proceed will be issued after the contract is fully executed.

This work shall be diligently prosecuted to Substantial Completion before the expiration of **120 WORKING DAYS** from the effective date of the Notice to Proceed, and to Final Completion before the expiration of **140 WORKING DAYS** from the effective date of the Notice to Proceed.

The Contractor shall pay to the City of Berkeley the sum of:

- a. Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) for each working day that expires after the time specified herein for the Contractor to achieve Substantial Completion until the work is Substantially Complete
 - b. Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each working day that expires after the time specified herein for the Contractor to achieve Final Completion until the work is Finally Complete.
6. To be considered, all bidders shall:
 - Be licensed under the provisions of Chapter 9, Division 3 of the Business and Professions Code of the State of California to do the type of work contemplated in the project. The general class or type of work called for under the Contract requires a class "A" license.
 - Meet other mandatory bid requirements set forth in the bid documents
 7. Inspection of Site: Bidder must examine and judge for itself the location of the proposed work and the nature and extent of the work to be done. The technical specifications, including drawings, plans, maps, diagrams and/or other graphic representations of the project, show conditions as they are supposed or believed by City to exist at the site, but the conditions shown do not constitute a representation by City that they actually exist. Utilities (underground or above-ground), buildings, structures and other improvements may be within or adjacent to the project site.
