

- Appealing
- Low water consumption
- ▶ Lighting





Portland Loo Details

- Prefabricated
- ▶ 6feet x10feet x 8feet
- ▶ Single stall
- ▶ ADA Compliant
- Detached hand washing station
- ▶ Solar Panels w/battery
