Subject: Berkeley Project Day – Saturday, November 5, 2022

Berkeley Project Day is on Saturday, November 5, 2022. Over 300 UC Berkeley students will perform volunteer service at eleven (11) project sites as provided below. The City typically coordinates two events per year, the larger event is in the Fall and the smaller event is in the Spring. Through a community agency contract with the Associated Students of the University of California (ASUC) in the amount of \$27,000 per year, this day of service involves a partnership between UC Berkeley, the City of Berkeley, and local park stewardship volunteers. The project involves approximately 600 student volunteers for two events per year.

Berkeley Project Day November 5, 2022

1. **Bay Trail** – 50 students. Staff and students will pick up trash from the Bay Trail leading into the Berkeley Waterfront and the Tom Bates Fields parking lots from Ashby to Gilman.
2. **James Kenney Park** – 40 students. Staff and students will plant and mulch the slope below the basketball and pickleball courts.
3. **Berkeley Design Center** – 40 students. Staff and students will continue to weed and prune planters, plant native, and mulch the landscape-planted areas on the sidewalk.
4. **Adeline Ave** – 25 students. Staff and students will spread mulch at this location and will move south along Adeline replenishing mulch in planters and planted areas.
5. **1638 Stuart St** – 25 students. Staff and students will remove weeds and will also spread mulch over planned landscape areas.
6. **Ohlone Dog Park**. Students will spread mulch in low areas of the large dog park.
7. **Aquatic Park** – 25 students. Students and volunteers will work with Waterside Workshops to pick up and bag trash along the shores of Aquatic Park.

8. **Halcyon Park** – Students will weed and spread mulch in the landscaped area of the park.
9. **Northside Community Garden** – Students and volunteers will spread mulch in the community garden.
10. **Shattuck Ave (DBA)** – Students will plant daffodil bulbs and spread mulch in planters.
11. **Lorin District (Friends of Lorin District)** - Students and volunteers will pick up and bag trash in the Lorin District.
