



Tuolumne Family Camp and Echo Lake Camp COVID-19 Related Protocols

This summer, we will be following the City of Berkeley and California Department of Public Health (CDPH) guidelines. Campers should expect the following COVID-19 related requirements:

Prior to Arrival: Attestation of Negative COVID-19 testing requirement

- Prior to arrival at Camp, we will require all campers ages 2 and older to provide an attestation that they have received a negative COVID-19 test (PCR tests must be conducted within 72 hours before arrival, or at-home antigen tests must be conducted within 24 hours of arrival).

We will require every camper to submit this 2022 Berkeley Tuolumne Camp COVID-19 Attestation Short Form prior to their Camp session.

- Prior to arrival at Camp, we will ask all Campers and Staff to complete a wellness check screening for COVID-19 symptoms as well as any recent close contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case.
- If campers or staff have any [COVID-19 symptoms](#) or have tested positive for COVID-19, they will not be allowed to attend and should not travel to Berkeley Tuolumne or Echo Lake Camp.
- We are encouraging unvaccinated participants to quarantine at home for a 10-day period prior to camp arrival, in addition to the required pre-entry testing for COVID-19 immediately prior to arrival.

At Arrival: Wellness Check Screening

- At check-in, we will conduct a wellness check screening for all incoming campers using the [City of Berkeley COVID Symptoms sign](#).
- Routinely throughout each Camp session, we will require wellness checks and monitor the health and well-being of staff and campers.

While at Camp:

- Campers will be required to wear masks indoors. Children under two years old are exempt from wearing masks.
- If someone exhibits symptoms at Camp, they will be isolated and tested for COVID-19.
 - Campers must remain in isolation until negative test results are received.
 - If a positive test result is received, we will require that individual to return home.

- Close contacts of individuals that have COVID-19 will be tested for COVID-19 and should wear a well-fitting mask around others for a total of 10 days.

After Camp:

Campers who exhibit symptoms after Camp should get tested for COVID-19. If you recently attended Tuolumne or Echo Lake Camp and receive a positive test result, we ask that you please contact our Camps Office immediately at (510) 981-5140 or camps@cityofberkeley.info so that we can work with public health providers to determine next steps. These changes are being implemented to look out for the health & safety of our Campers and staff, and we appreciate campers' willingness to follow these protocols.
