Re: Inclement Weather Shelter

Due to the extreme weather event predicted by the National Weather Service, the City, in partnership with Dorothy Day House, opened an Inclement Weather Shelter at 6 pm tonight in Old City Hall. HHCS distributed notification of the shelter opening.

This shelter will be open nightly for evenings in which the overnight forecast has a 50% or higher chance of rain and/or is forecast to drop below 45 degrees. On December 2nd the shelter is scheduled to open for the season. The shelter, which has a capacity of 25, opens at 6 PM and is first-come, first-served.

- OPERATED BY: Dorothy Day House
- OPEN DATES: When weather criteria are met.
- HOURS OF OPERATION: Monday-Saturday, 6 p.m. – 8 a.m.
- BED CAPACITY: 25 beds
- MEALS: Dinner served
- ACCESS: first come, first served

In addition, Dorothy Day Community Resource Center, 1931 Center, will open at 8:15 a.m. to accommodate individuals during the day.
