






**2.6 MILLION** people attended cultural events in Berkeley in 2016

**\$500,000** from the City of Berkeley allocated to artists and organizations in 2016

**6,783** jobs provided in Berkeley by the arts sector in 2016

**152** arts and culture nonprofits exist in Berkeley in 2016


