## **STAIR Center Overview**



- Opened June 27, 2018
- Three program components:
  - Sustained outreach to City's encampments
  - 24/7, low-barrier and service-rich shelter
  - Large flexible fund to assist clients with access to permanent housing.
- Year 1 Budget = \$2.44M
- Year 2 Budget = \$2.41M



# **Results-Based Accountability**

RBA measures program performance with three key questions:

- How much did we do?
- How well did we do it?
- Is anyone better off?





#### STAIR SHELTER DEMOGRAPHICS







Length of time to get housed	~3 months	~9 months
% who return to homelessness	22%	22%
