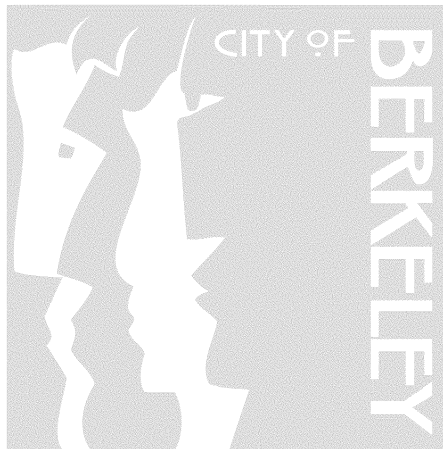

## QUESTIONS ABOUT YOUR BILL

If you have questions about your bill, please call the Marina Office at (510) 981-6740. When making a written inquiry, please include your name, slip number, account number, and a description of the issue. You do not have to pay amounts in question while we investigate, but you are obligated to pay the parts of your bill that are not in question.

## PAYMENT INFORMATION

You may pay by cash, check, debit card, or credit card (Visa or Mastercard) at our Customer Service Center located at 1947 Center Street, 1st Floor, Monday to Thursday, 8:30am to 2:00pm. You may also make payments at the Marina Office up to the last weekday of the prior month. ## LATE PAYMENTS AND FEES

Payment for the next month is due on or before the 1st of that month. Failure to remit payment on time may result in your keys being turned off, a 10% late payment penalty, a \$120 chaining fee, and/or a \$100 lien fee, a \$75 service fee, or other remedial actions in Berkeley Municipal Code.

## DELINQUENT ACCOUNTS

**Section 6.20.050 of the Berkeley Municipal Code provides for the following:**

- A. No person shall remove or cause to be removed from the marina any vessel upon which charges for berthing, dry storage, or any other charges are delinquent, without first paying all such delinquent charges. The Harbormaster is authorized to take actions necessary to prevent the removal of a vessel in violation of this subsection, including moving, securing, or otherwise detaining the vessel.
- C. When any charges upon a vessel are delinquent for 20 days or more the City may post a notice of delinquency and secure the vessel to prevent it from being moved. The City may add a service charge to the berther's account for securing the vessel.
- D. When subsequent to securing a vessel for delinquent charges as provided in subsection D of this section, any charges remain delinquent and unpaid, the City may enforce the lien pursuant to the procedures set forth in the Boaters Lien Law of the California Harbors and Navigation Code.

## CANCELLATIONS

Per Berkeley Municipal Code 6.20.060, cancellation of permit to berth requires a 30-day written notification to the Harbormaster at the Marina Office (201 University Ave, Berkeley, CA 94710) or by fax (510-981-6745).
