

# Existing gates on McKinley Ave



### Benefits:

- reduces traffic during school hours

### Challenges:

- difficult for Zero Waste to access street when gates are closed
- requires school staff to open/close
- reduces Fire department/emergency access
- limits bicycle access
- doesn't reduce speeds or traffic when gates are open outside of school hours

# Which option for McKinley Ave do you prefer?

## Upgraded swinging gates



school hours

Benefits: improves bicycle access, reduces vehicle traffic, can be moved out of the way by Fire department and Zero Waste.

Challenges: requires school staff to open and close.

## Removable bollards



school hours

Benefits: can be moved out of the way of Fire and/or emergency vehicles with a key, improves bicycle access.

Challenges: less visible than other options, requires school staff to open and close, may still allow smaller vehicles to pass through unimpeded.

## Raised crossing



24-7

Benefits: slows vehicle speeds, makes pedestrians more visible, allows bike access.

Challenges: can cause delays to vehicles including Fire trucks/emergency response vehicles.

## Concrete Diverter



24-7

Benefits: allows bicycle access, reduces vehicle traffic, allows 24-7 Fire/emergency access.

Challenges: may not divert as much traffic as other options if cars/trucks try to pass through.
