**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
**STRAWBERRY CREEK CULVERT MAINTENANCE PROJECT**  
**PHASE 1**

The City of Berkeley Public Works Department will be rehabilitating sections of the Strawberry Creek culvert maintained by the City in your neighborhood. The project includes localized structural repairs and the lining of the culvert with a geopolymer mortar. These repairs and lining will be done from inside the culverts, eliminating the need for excavation. For more information about the project, please scan the QR code at the bottom of the page.

**LOCATION:** Sections of Strawberry Creek culvert between the western edge of Civic Center Park and the daylighted creek section west of Sacramento Street. See location map inside.

**TIMELINE:** Construction is expected to begin in May 2025 and will take approximately six months to complete, depending on weather or unforeseen conditions. Please note the construction in your immediate vicinity will not extend for this entire period. Standard work hours are 7:30 a.m. - 5:00 p.m., Monday - Friday

**POSSIBLE INCONVENIENCES:** Traffic control may cause delays near the work site, and street closures may be necessary but will not exceed 12-hours at a time. "No Parking" signs will be posted along the street 3 - days in advance and will be enforced by the Police Department. Please see the posted signs for exact hours and locations as they will vary according to scheduled tasks. All other usual parking restrictions, including no parking for street cleaning, will continue to be in effect. Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times. Residents will be notified in advance of any lane or street closure.


