ECHO LAKE & TUOLUMNE CAMPS



Escape to the Sierra Nevada with the City of Berkeley: we have summer sleepaway camps for youth, families, adults, and seniors. You can swim in a lake, hike in the forest, enjoy meals cooked for you, or let your children explore the wonders of the high sierras with counselors.

Family Camps

Tuolumne: June 12–August 13 (9 weeks)

Echo Lake: June 12–June 18; September 1–4

All Ages. At either Echo Lake or Tuolumne Camp, families can enjoy the wilderness, great food, and all-day programming for kids. Choose from week-long, weekday, and weekend camp visits. Enjoy campfires and s'mores, take part in theme days, play games, practice archery, swim, and learn crafts.

Note: Fees cover up to 3 people with option to add campers for a fee, up to 6 per tent.

Youth Camps

Echo Lake: June 19–August 19

Ages 7-14. Our Youth Camp at Echo Lake offers a week-long opportunity for kids ages 7 to 14 to experience the natural world, make new friends, have fun, and grow confidence.

These 5-day or 6-day sessions include activities such as hiking, swimming, archery, arts & crafts, campfires, talent shows, group games, and more.

Family Swim

Time for families to swim together in the shallow section of the pool. Children under 7 years and less than 42” in height must be accompanied in the pool by parent or guardian, who must remain within arm’s reach at all times. No more than 2 children who are under 7 years old or less than 42” in height, per adult.

Lap Swim

Swim time in an organized lane environment. Note: During certain times, instructional/coached programs will have priority in lane assignment and space.

Independent Exercise (Dive Tank)

This provides time to exercise in the 10-12 ft. deep pool without an instructor. The diving board will not be available for use at this time.

Independent Exercise (Shallow)

This provides time to exercise in shallow section of the lap pool without an instructor. The diving board will not be available for use at this time.

Berkeley Aquatic Masters*

Year-round swim team providing structured, coached workouts for adult competitive and fitness swimmers, and triathletes.

New swimmers welcome.

Community Swim

All areas of the pool are open for play. All groups with 10 or more children must submit a written request for a swim date, at least 5 days prior to their planned arrival at the pool. Lap swim lanes are not available. Children under 7 years or under 42” tall, must be accompanied on deck and in the pool by a parent or guardian, 18 years or older. A swim test must be passed to be admitted to the deep area of the pools.
