- Received FEMA Grant for MLK Jr /Y.A.P. Community Center awarded \$1,237,500 augmenting \$7 million of T1 Funding
- Received \$1 million federal earmark for African American Holistic Resource Center
- Received \$15 million state earmark for Berkeley Marina Projects
- Waiting on \$750,000 Land and Water Grant for Grove Park which will augment T1 Phase 2 Funds for play equipment
- Waiting on FEMA Grant for South Berkeley Senior Center renovations
- Waiting on potential federal earmark for MLK Jr /Y.A.P. Community Center

Facilities/Buildings

- 1947 Center: HVAC upgrades in design.
- Fire Stations 2: In design.
- Fire Station 6: In design.
- PW Main Corp Yard: Green and H buildings in design.

- South Berkeley Senior Center: In design, still no word regarding FEMA grant.
- Solar batteries: Pending completion of NBSC.

Restrooms

- Restrooms in ROW: Telegraph/Channing in design.
 - Finalizing locations at San Pablo/University and Adeline/Alcatraz.
- Restroom at Telegraph Channing garage: Will be coordinated with elevator upgrade which is funded with new CIP.
- Restroom in Harrison Park: Preparing a Request for Proposal for a design consultant.

Parks

- John Hinkel Park Renovations: Construction almost complete. Ribbon-Cutting to coincide with Music in the Park, Saturday, July 16, 2022.
- King Pool Tile and Plaster Replacement: Construction complete. Pool is open, punch list and final items remain.
- Grove Park Field and Playground Renovation: In construction documents phase of design. Awaiting status of a grant application before submitting for permit.
- Ohlone Park Playground: In final design, scheduled for construction next year.
- Civic Center Park Turtle Garden: Consultants under contract. In design phase. Meeting with Indigenous groups to frame project
- Willard Clubhouse/Restroom Replacement: In design. Zoning Permit application submitted, awaiting review of submitted application.
- MLK Jr. Youth Services Center Renovation: In design. Completed 5 Community Meetings and Teen Workshops.
- African American Holistic Resource Center: awarding design contract at Council on 07/26/22.
- Ohlone Park Lighting and Restroom: Negotiating contract with Landscape Architect.
- Aquatic Park Tide Tubes Clean out, Phase 1B: Construction anticipates to start in August, 2022

Waterfront

- Piling Replacement: In design and permitting phase, construction Summer 2023.
- D&E Dock Replacement: In 30% Design Development
- Tom Bates Restroom/Community Space: Design to begin in August, 2022
- K-Dock Restroom and Cesar Chavez Park Bathroom: Design will begin in FY23

Streets/Storm Water/Pathways

- Streets: In design, scheduled for construction next summer.
- Bollard conversion to landscaping: In planning to finalize locations.
- Sidewalks: Construction contract awarded at June 28, 2022 Council meeting. Construction scheduled to start this fall.
- Pathway Improvements: Construction in progress; work to date at Florida, Turnbridge, Visalia, Fountain, La Vereda/Virginia, and new signs at various paths. Construction at Vincente, Upper Orchard, and Tamalpais scheduled for later this year.
- Storm Improvements: John Hinkel completed. Construction underway on Marin, Euclid, Spruce, Grizzly Peak, San Benito, High Court and Virginia.


