Marina Streets (University Avenue, Marina Blvd., Spinnaker Way)- This project is nearing completion. Ribbon Cutting will be in May 2022.

North Berkeley Senior Center- This project is nearing completion. Ribbon Cutting TBA

Phase 2 Project Updates

Facilities/Buildings

1947 Center Street Improvements: Architect under contract, Design started

Fire Station 2 Improvements: In process of bringing on an Architect

Fire Station 6 Improvements: Architect under contract, Design started

African American Holistic Resource Center: Project Manager (Cumming Group) is in place, Structural Engineer on board to do seismic analysis, Haz Materials survey bids are due Monday, and Scope for designer/architect in process.

Willard Clubhouse and Restroom: ELS is completing schematic designs.

Martin Luther King Jr. Youth Services Center(YAP): Design firm Segal and Strain has started. First public meeting is this Thursday. Staff awaiting result of \$1.2 M FEMA grant application

Tom Bates Sports Complex Restroom and Community Space: In process of awarding Design contract. Pickleball and small soccer field added to design. Cal Trans project that will expand sewer line to front of complex is starting soon

Telegraph Avenue Restroom: Public Process Complete, In Design Development

2 ROW Restrooms: In process of bringing on an architect

Channing Garage Restrooms renovations: Architect on board, Design started

Harrison Restroom: Developing scope for Architect

Parks

Ohlone Park 2-5, 5-12 and Mural Garden: BASE Design firm is in the process of turning the final conceptual and schematic designs into final designs. After design is complete and permits are acquired, this will be out for construction bid in Fall of 2022.

Ohlone Lighting and Restroom Project: Developing scope for Landscape Architect.

John Hinkel Park Storm Drain, Picnic, Amphitheatre, and 2-12 Playground: After months of under-ground and creek work, the above ground features that include new elements in the amphitheater, picnic area, parking and a 2-12 year old play structure are starting to take shape. Ribbon cutting is planned for June 25, 2022 (tentative).

Grove Park Sports Field, 2-5 and 5-12 Play Structures: RRM Design is completing final design for Sports field and 2-5 and 5-12 year old playground improvements. Before bidding for construction, staff is waiting for the result of Land and Water Conservation Grant in September of 2022

Civic Center Park Turtle Garden: PGA Design firm_scope is complete. Clean California Grant of \$590,000k for upper plaza area awarded last month. Public process to begin soon.

Aquatic Park Tide Tubes- Soil Removal: Currently bidding. Construction to start summer of 2022

King Pool Tile and Plaster Replacement: The complete replacement of tile and plaster at this pool has been combined with the West Campus Pool Tile, Plaster and Filter replacement project. Contract docs in process. Construction will start and finish before the end of May.

Waterfront

Marina D and E Dock Replacement: Marine Engineer on board for design. Project kicking off this week

Marina Misc. Piling Replacement: Completing design, CEQA and permitting. Construction to start June of 2023

Streets/Storm Water/Pathways Street, Bike Ped Improvements –

Bollard Conversion to Landscaping: Developing scope of work and outreach program.

Pathways: Handrail installation scheduled for this spring at several paths; new and replacement signage underway; engineering evaluation underway at Columbia Path.

Stormwater: Completed storm drain construction at John Hinkel Park. Contract awarded to Cratus Inc. for construction of storm drain improvements at Marin Avenue, Virginia Street, Grizzly Peak Boulevard and High Court. Construction scheduled for this summer.

Sidewalk: Currently bidding. Construction scheduled to this summer.


