

T1 Quarterly Update

October 31, 2019

Since the last update to Council on July 23, 2019, staff have accomplished the following:

1. Hired an Auditor to audit the first two years of expenditures charged to Measure T1. A kick-off meeting with the auditor was held on **October 16, 2019** with a report anticipated by January 2020. Audits are planned for every two years of the bond program.
2. Met with the T1 Joint Subcommittee to develop a public process for Phase 2 on **July 8, 2019, August 12, 2019, and September 16, 2019**. Staff and committee members established a thorough process to obtain feedback from community members regarding projects for Phase 2. This process includes multiple opportunities for community members to provide feedback including 15-20 Council-recommended neighborhood group meetings, 5 large geographic-based public meetings, e-mail, and an online survey for those who would not be able to attend the scheduled public meetings.
3. Met with the Public Works and Parks and Waterfront Commissions on **October 3, 2019** and **October 9, 2019** to discuss the public process for Phase 2.
4. Held public meetings and attended events to solicit input from the community for the following projects:
