PUBLIC NOTICE
ROAD CLOSURE ON MARIN AVENUE
DECEMBER 19-22

The City of Berkeley, Public Work Department, will be performing concrete repair work on Marin Avenue.

LOCATION: Construction will be on Marin Avenue between Spruce Street and Euclid Avenue, specifically at the intersection of Regal Road and just uphill from Spruce Street.

TIMELINE: Construction will be December 19-22, dependent on weather and unforeseen conditions. **The road will be fully closed during this time period.** There will also be a paving operation at Spruce and Euclid intersections December 27-30 but these will be done with a flagging operation, no closure, but expect delays.

Standard work hours are 7:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

REASONING: The work is associated with the recently completed storm drain improvements on Marin and adjacent streets. Due to the steep grade on Marin, the majority of the street is made of concrete. In order to repair the locations, the old concrete must be completely removed and new concrete poured, which can take up to two (2) days to set up and harden. Traffic cannot drive on the new concrete until it completely sets and hardens, thus the need for the full closure.

Scheduling of this work has been done to coincide with the holiday break of the Cragmont Elementary School.

TRAFFIC DETOURS: Traffic will be able to travel uphill on Marin to Spruce, but will need to turn right or left. Cross traffic on Spruce will be open.

Traffic will be able to travel downhill on Marin to Euclid, but will need to turn right or left. Cross traffic on Euclid will be open.

Traffic on Cragmont will be able to cross Marin, but not turn right or left on Marin. Residents on Marin will be able to make these turns to access their homes.

The Regal intersection will be completely closed. South residents will access off Euclid and north residents can access off Cragmont.

There will be a series of detour signs throughout the area to assist in guiding traffic around the area.
