Interest Form Is Live

All prospective YouthWorkers must fill out an interest form located on the [YouthWorks webpage](#) of the City of Berkeley's website. All candidates, including returning candidates, will be required to fill out an interest form.

Onboarding/Orientation/Placement

YouthWorkers will go through an extensive onboarding process, including a livescan, have an orientation to learn fundamental professional skills, and complete their Neogov online training required by all City of Berkeley Staff. **All steps must be completed in order to begin employment.**

YW Workshops Begin

Both participants and mentors will be invited to workshops. Workshops for interns are weekly and pertain to life skills that supplement their work experience at sites. Mentor workshops are discussions and topics pertaining to best practices supporting YouthWorkers at various sites.
