

<p><b>Overview of Use of Force Incident Reporting &amp; Accountability (45 min) :</b></p> <p><b>(15 min)</b></p> <p><b>(15 min)</b></p> <p><b>(5 min)</b></p> <p><b>(10 min)</b></p>	<p><b>Reporting Requirements and Processes (15 min):</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Discuss the requirement in <a href="#">Policy 300.6</a> for documenting all uses of force in a report, which must be prompt, complete, and accurate</li> <li>• Officers are required to articulate the factors perceived and why they believed the use of force was objectively reasonable and necessary</li> </ul> <p><b>Supervisor Responsibilities and Internal Reviews (15 min):</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Highlight the role of supervisors as outlined in <a href="#">Policy 300.6.1</a>, including their responsibility to respond to use of force incidents, gather facts, ensure medical assistance, and review body-worn camera footage</li> <li>• Review the different levels of use of force reporting (Levels 1-4) and the requirements for each level</li> </ul> <p><b>Transparency Measures (15 min):</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Discuss <a href="#">Policy 300.11</a>, which mandates a comprehensive analysis of use of force incidents, reported quarterly and annually, including demographic details and trends</li> <li>• Emphasize the requirement for public reporting via the <a href="#">City's Open Data Portal</a> and to the <a href="#">Police Accountability Board</a></li> </ul>
