## 2019 Local Hazard Mitigation Plan

Final
December 10, 2019

- Appendix to General Plan
- Collects and presents:
  - Updated hazard information
  - Mitigation activities planned/funded and other proposals that require additional funding
- Adopted 2004, 2014, 2019
- Update required by December 2024 to maintain eligibility for post-disaster recovery money and hazard mitigation funding



## **LHMP & General Plan Safety Element**

2024 Local Hazard Mitigation Plan	Safety Element Update
Identify latest hazard information	Identify hazard information consistent with LHMP
Compile City's mitigation efforts into a 5- year mitigation strategy	<ul> <li>Establish citywide goals, policies, actions:</li> <li>Reduce risk from hazards</li> <li>Address climate adaptation, resilience and equity</li> </ul>
Provide analysis to meet new State evacuation planning requirements	Integrate evacuation analysis into Citywide goals, policies and actions
Updated every 5 years	Updated every 8 years








## **Readiness = Mitigation + Preparedness**

- Mitigation: Reduce or eliminate disaster impacts
- Preparedness: Increase emergency response capability







## Readiness = Mitigation + Preparedness

#### Mitigation:

- Strengthening structures
- Making land use decisions that will minimize damage
- Reducing vegetation in high-fire areas
- Strapping down water heaters

#### **Preparedness:**

- Purchasing equipment to use in emergency response
- Conducting disaster response drills
- Storage of disaster supplies

## **New in 2024: Evacuation Analysis**

- Included to meet new State requirements
  - SB 99: Residential developments with 1 way out
  - AB 747: Evacuation routes, capacities, safety, viability
  - AB 1409: Evacuation locations
- Will include **preliminary analysis** from Evacuation Time Study



## **Planning Commission Role**

- Timeline: Winter 2023 through Fall 2024
- Planning Commission Focus
  - Ensure consistency with the General Plan and process
  - Specific review of land use planning actions in Mitigation Strategy
- Host 2 public meetings (along with Disaster & Fire Safety Commission)
  - Meeting 1: First Draft LHMP (Dec 2023 or Jan 2024)
    - Action (optional): Commission feedback on Mitigation Strategy
  - Meeting 2: Final Draft (est. Oct 2024) First Public Hearing
    - Action: Recommend Final Draft Plan adoption by Council
