




The complaint alleges that the Committee failed to properly report certain expenditures on its election reports, as well as potential noncompliance with rules related to disclaimers on campaign communications.

As an area resident, I was curious to review Ruben’s election committee filed its April 17th 2024 Form 460 which is seemingly without reporting of what appear to be significant expenses, listing only campaign signs, ActBlue & Credit Card fees, and the state & local filing fees.

Evidently left out items include a mass text (seemingly directly from the campaign which have reached a number of my personal acquaintances in the district) which did not include FPPC information/a ”Paid for by” disclaimer and which does not appear in the 460 as an expense either through a service or third party vendor, and hosting fees for the campaign website <https://www.ruben4berkeley.com/> (which includes a standard “paid for by” disclaimer- Paid for by Ruben Hernandez Story for Council 2024, FPPC ID # 1467466

Copyright © 2024, All rights reserved.) Also seemingly missing are fees for the 4 staff members, (if paid as the answer seems to suggest) mentioned in questionnaires such as this one at <https://t.ly/k4Bf7> including/as well as the Campaign Manager, Treasurer, and Consultant listed.

If these are oversights, they should be correctable, but if paid for by personal funds or third parties, I believe this would constitute a violation of both 460 filing requirements and rules of the financing program, giving a significant advantage to Ruben Hernandez

As a Mexican immigrant and first-generation college graduate who grew up in Section 8 housing, I know firsthand the kinds of sacrifices working people have to make to support themselves and their families. I am committed to redressing the historic harm done to marginalized communities and ensuring that the City of Berkeley and our partner institutions are accountable for uplifting and supporting the workers whose labor keeps them afloat. As a public servant, organizer, and leader with over eight years of experience at the state and local level, I am best positioned to build the coalitions and consensus necessary to advance the Berkeley City Council's legacy of pragmatic, progressive policies and reforms. My desire to continue serving the community that has welcomed me and my fiancée with open arms is what is driving this campaign. I care about my neighbors and I care about the community I have called home for the last six years. I have the experience necessary to make the right decisions and the ability to bring people together amidst divides on our council, decisions rooted in ensuring that our District 4 neighbors are heard and represented well. I will fight to address the housing supply and affordability crisis and protect renters like me, reduce our greenhouse gas emissions through a climate and mobility justice lens, strengthen community policing, accountability, and non-police intervention so that our officers can focus on addressing violent crimes and thefts, provide compassionate care for our unsheltered neighbors - not criminalize them, revitalize our Downtown and invest in our restaurants, nightlife, arts, and cultural programming while ensuring worker protections and economic mobility, and work transparently with city staff to balance our workload and diversify and increase our revenue sources.

When I moved to Berkeley in 2018, one of the first things I did was look up “young Democrats”, and the East Bay Young Democrats showed up on my feed. I went to the next meeting - and the rest was history. I am proud to be a long-time member and board member, especially now that I have the honor of serving as president. My entire California history (and future) is tied to EBYD and the amazing community it has provided. We have to deal with the consequences of today, tomorrow, and we are owed more than lip service. Please provide examples of projects, votes, or propositions through which you have supported/led young people. \*

In EBYD and LYDEB, I have served in various capacities, including president, policy director, communications director, and more. Whether presiding over meetings, ensuring that fellow board members views and perspectives are heard and that we are sharing the workload, researching and gathering data on legislation and candidates for our endorsement consideration, or compiling our messages and stories for our newsletter and social media accounts, I have spent the last six years in leadership positions supporting and leading young people, while also being supported and led by young people myself. In my day jobs, I have also led interns and supported them by giving them the space to grow into their roles while ensuring that their internship goals were being met. A lot of the work that I have worked on over the last eight years as a legislative aide has had direct impacts on young people - a Berkeley Green New Deal, bus, cycling, and pedestrian improvements, increasing the housing supply and affordability, economic recovery, and more. Anything I work on is largely done through the eyes of how it particularly impacts young people, especially those younger than me. We need to invest in a pipeline of young leadership and look out for future generations, always.

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What do you think are the top three issues impacting young people (age 14-35) that are relevant to the office you are seeking? (please rank in order of priority) \*

Housing affordability and stability  
Climate and mobility justice  
Equitable economic recovery

For each of the three issues listed above, what is a policy you would propose to address that issue? \*

I will invest in the city's affordable housing trust fund, rental assistance, eviction protection, and ownership opportunities, work to streamline the permitting process for new homes being built, including ADUs, tiny homes, and middle housing, and advance innovative solutions like the city's social housing pilot and housing preference policy to redress the displacement of low-income households of color. I believe a housing-first approach is critical to serving our unhoused neighbors. I will invest in rapid rehousing services, transitional housing, and permanent supportive housing for individuals with severe mental health needs, as demonstrated by the Hope Center on Berkeley Way.

I will support transit-first policies and infrastructure, such as bicycle and pedestrian safety improvements, bus rapid transit, pedestrian plazas, bringing the Berkeley ferry online, and expanding access to electric micro-mobility options for low-income residents such as e-bike rebate programs and subsidized bike share and transit passes for residents in transit-oriented multifamily buildings. I will support transit oriented development. Building more housing near jobs, transit, and amenities feeds three birds with one stone: it improves housing availability and affordability, it reduces traffic into Berkeley, and it lowers emissions. I will work to update our natural gas prohibition and energy efficiency standards to advance building decarbonization and increase our investment in ongoing zero waste strategies, such as compost bins for retailers and multifamily apartment buildings.

I will support our arts, culture, hospitality, restaurants, and nightlife by improving safety and transit access to enable more late-night dining and entertainment in our downtown business district. I will work with business groups, community nonprofits, and the UC to attract new and retain legacy businesses. I will support adaptive reuse of underutilized commercial buildings and improve staffing and streamlining to speed up permitting for new small, local businesses. I will support the right to organize for all workers and workplace and hazard protections. I will support apprenticeships, health care, labor standards, and project labor agreements.

How would you address the obstacles (political, budgetary, etc.) that you would need to overcome to implement the policies you proposed? Please be reasonably specific; a plan with no real prospect of enactment does little to help young people (age 14-35). \*

I will support replenishing the City's Reserve Fund and expanding and diversifying citywide revenue sources to pay for existing and future programs and provide resilience in the face of economic changes. I will work with the City Manager and City Auditor to identify cost savings opportunities without reducing services, such as updating technology to streamline operations and service delivery. I will ensure an orderly and transparent annual budget process to enable community input on City priorities and focus resources on critical operations. My goal will be to bring a voice to the council that is both progressive and pragmatic and that is going to uplift all voices in the District, including if we are initially on opposing sides of an issue, in order to ensure that everyone is heard in the decision making process. I will work diligently to have a constant stream of communication with residents via my newsletter, social media accounts, meetings, and community conversations, including with community leaders, organizations, and unions, in order to ensure that all perspectives are heard, validated, and used to make final decisions. Another goal will be to be mindful of city staff capacity when it comes to passing too many referrals that end up in a giant backlog while we are understaffed as well as being mindful of how elected officials and management treat staff and holding each other accountable when mistreatment occurs. I will also promote opportunities to work at the City of Berkeley through my newsletter, social media accounts, and communications with constituents.

I was born in Mexico and raised in South Texas by a single mother in Section 8 housing along with my two siblings. Watching my mother struggle to make ends meet as a teacher's assistant making minimum wage taught me the importance of hard work and education from a young age. After graduating in the top 10 of my high school, I was the first in my family to graduate from college, earning a degree in International Relations and Diplomacy from the Ohio State University. Since graduating, I have been committed to public service, working to ensure that disadvantaged communities receive the support they need. I have worked in the offices of U.S. Senator Sherrod Brown, Ohio State Senator Cecil Thomas, Richmond Mayor Tom Butt, and Berkeley Councilmember Terry Taplin, where I currently serve as his chief of staff. I have worked to advance initiatives on gun violence prevention and criminal justice reform, creating housing near BART stations, developing a West Berkeley Green New Deal, expanding bus and ferry service alongside electric vehicle charging, and improving safety for pedestrians and cyclists. After moving to Berkeley in 2018, I became deeply involved in the community. In addition to my work in Berkeley City Hall, I serve as president of the East Bay Young Democrats and as immediate past president of the Latine Young Democrats of the East Bay, where I have helped uplift voices of young people and people of color and give them a seat at the table. 

## Background

The Berkeley Election Reform Act (BERA), BMC 2.12, requires that Campaign Communications<sup>1</sup> include

...the phrase “Major Funding Provided By” immediately followed by the name of the contributor, the city of domicile, and the total cumulative sum of contributions by each of the top four contributors over \$250<sup>2</sup> to the committee funding the expenditure made within six months of the expenditure” ([BMC 2.12.335](#)).

“Californians for Safety and Security”<sup>3</sup> is a committee formed for the purpose of sending anonymous hateful mailers to oppose a Berkeley City Council candidate. 100% of its funding comes from three organizations: The Berkeley Property Owners Association (BPOA)<sup>4</sup> (\$13,500)<sup>5</sup>, the Los Angeles police union<sup>6</sup> (\$49,000)<sup>7</sup>, and the Personal Insurance Federation Committee<sup>8</sup> (\$5,000)<sup>9</sup>. The Personal Insurance Federation Committee made its \$5,000 contribution to Respondent on April 14, 2024<sup>10</sup>; since that money was donated far less than six months before the May 28 special election for City Council District 4, Respondent is mandated to list the Personal Insurance Federation’s \$5,000 donation on Campaign Communications.<sup>11</sup>

Respondent has blatantly (and repeatedly) refused to follow this law, thereby corruptly and maliciously misleading the electorate through illegal “dark money” practices.




## Complaint #1: Failure to include required disclosure on Hit Piece Mailer

On or about April 30, 2024, Respondent mass mailed a hit piece against Soli Alpert. Below is a copy of said hit piece



This hit piece undoubtedly qualifies as a Campaign Communication under BMC 2.12.335; yet, Respondent refused to include the critical major funders disclosure which is legally mandated by that section of BERA.

## Complaint #2: Failure to include required disclosure on Youtube Ad(s)

Respondent's Form 496 (Report No. 2024.4IE) shows expenditures for "Digital Ads Opposing Soli Alpert." A Berkeley resident informed us of a hit piece against Soli Alpert by Respondent as a video advertisement on Youtube, and that said Youtube hit piece failed to include the BMC 2.12.335 disclosure.

Based on the description of the ad, it is clear that it qualifies as a Campaign Communication under BMC 2.12.335; yet, Respondent reportedly refused to include the critical major funders disclosure which is legally mandated by that section of BERA.

In summary, it is apparent that Respondent failed to put the mandatory disclosure on the Youtube ad as well. The Commission must subpoena records to confirm that Respondent has been illegally disseminating a hit piece on Youtube without including the legally mandated disclosure statement.

### **Complaint #3: Failure to include required disclosure on Other Political Ad(s)**

Respondent's Form 496 (Report No. 2024.41E) lists two separate independent expenditures for "Digital Ads Opposing Soli Alpert," both of which are dated May 2. One may reasonably infer that they took out multiple digital hit pieces against Mr. Alpert (in addition to the aforementioned hit piece running on Youtube). Furthermore, it is likely that these one or more additional digital ads qualify as Campaign Communications under BMC 2.12.335.

Given the confirmed refusal to include the mandatory disclosure on the mass mailed hit piece, the reported refusal to include the legally mandated disclosure in the hit piece running on Youtube, and the likelihood that one or more of these additional digital ads qualify as Campaign Communications under BMC 12.12.335, they likely also illegally refused to include such disclosures on one or more other digital ads as well. The Commission must subpoena records to determine just how many digital ads that Respondents have been illegally disseminating without including legally mandated disclosure statements.


### **Aggravating Circumstances**

When sanctioning the Respondent, the Commission should consider the following aggravating circumstances:

- It is virtually impossible to cure these violations.
- Complying with the law's requirements to disclose major funding on these hit pieces would have provided voters with the crucial and legally mandated information that Respondent is a corporate-funded group that is trying to sway their votes. Instead, their refusal to comply with the law misled voters to assume that Respondent is a grassroots-funded organization that received no cumulative donations from a single source of \$250 or more within the previous six months.
- A significant amount of Respondent's budget is provided by the Berkeley Property Owners Association (BPOA)<sup>12</sup>, which represents Berkeley's largest landlords who oppose the candidate who is vice-chair of the Berkeley Rent Stabilization Board.
- Respondent must be aware of its legal requirements under Berkeley law. Just above BMC 2.12.335 (requiring Campaign Communications list major funders) is BMC 2.12.330 (Mass mailings by independent expenditure (required notice)). Respondent's mailer appears to have complied with that requirement, yet does not comply with the very next section of the law because doing so would require them to let voters know who actually funds them.
- Respondent has violated both state and Berkeley campaign finance laws in order to illegally obscure their activity. For instance, despite indicating on their Form 410 that they are a State Committee, they filed their Form 410 with the City of Berkeley instead of with the State. They also appear to have failed to include the disclosures mandated by BMC 12.335 in Campaign Communications they sent about Berkeley's 2022 election. Based on this demonstrated pattern of violations, we request that the Commission thoroughly investigate these and any other potential violations by Respondent that the Commission may uncover.

Dear Open Government Commissioners,

Both the Human Welfare and Community Action Commission and the Commission on Disability have disabled commissioners attending commission meetings by zoom, however, even though the commissioners are connecting by zoom, the zoom link is not shared with the public requiring the public to attend in person. (complaint #1)

It is nearly four years since we started using zoom for city meetings. City staff, elected and appointed officials should all know by now how zoom works. The public with access to zoom capable devices are well aware of how to use zoom to attend meetings.

The fact that existing equipment in city buildings is not available for commission meetings should fall into the inexcusable. The fact that there are already meetings being conducted in rooms that are fully equipped for hybrid meetings and that the equipment is not being utilized and that other conference rooms in city buildings are not being utilized for hybrid meetings when there are commissions requesting hybrid meetings is inexcusable.

While there may on occasion be a shortage of equipped rooms when multiple meetings are being held at the same time, there should be sufficient equipped rooms for the commissions that are currently requesting hybrid meetings. (complaint #2)

The current situation strikes this Berkeley resident as policy.

The following are three excerpts from my March 14 2024 Activist's Diary published in the Berkeley Daily Planet describing the March 6, 2024 Human Welfare and Community Action Commission meeting that was made unnecessarily difficult by not using the equipment available in the Cypress Room and misrepresenting that the commission chair was connecting by phone when the commissioner was actually on zoom. As you read these comments, consider that your current meeting location is in the same fully equipped Cypress Room at 2180 Milvia and the OGC and FCPC is not available to the public as a hybrid meeting. (complaint #3)

Wednesday March 6, I attended the Human Welfare and Community Action Commission in the Cypress Room at 2180 Milvia. This is important as the Cypress Room is fully equipped for hybrid meetings to connect people on zoom and people in the room. City staff told those of us in the room, the commission's chair Mary Behm-Steinberg (who told us she was recovering from surgery) would be joining by phone.

I learned after the meeting closed that the depiction of Behm-Steinberg calling in by phone was not true. Behm-Steinberg was connecting to the meeting on her computer using the zoom link proved by staff to attend the meeting.

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The next item was the commission's recommendation on the distribution of funding for community agencies. As this discussion was getting started, the staff secretary Katz left the room and then returned telling the commissioners and public the building security person's

shift was ending at 8:30 pm and they needed to be out of the building by 8:45 pm giving the commission about an hour to decide how to respond to applications for funding totaling \$1,113,124 with only \$563,266 in funds to distribute.

With the commission chair already on ZOOM, if the meeting had been set up to use the equipment in the room, commissioner Jose Lara Cruz could have displayed the budget sheet on his computer on the large screen for everyone to see including the commission chair at home. Commissioner Lara Cruz had all the current funding and application requests in the accounting program Excel, where adding or subtracting funding would show the impact on the total funds available.

But instead we sat with inadequate meeting documents, separate pieces of paper, while Catherine Hutching was trying to respond to the discussion in the room and put the organizations being called out on a white board on the wall for the commissioners present to see. I had my own scratch sheet trying to keep up with the changing recommendations to squeeze over more than a million dollars in application requests into \$563,266.

It was totally unnecessary chaos, but it is demonstrative of the unwillingness of the City of Berkeley administration to use the tools/technology already available in the facilities when that use means supporting the commissioners and commissions, and it is demonstrative of this mayor and this city council's failure to step in and insist that existing equipment be made available for public meetings.

When the City of Berkeley is already on notice of non-compliance by the State of California, one would think the City of Berkeley would be doing everything possible to support the Human Welfare and Community Action Commission commissioners.

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I've attended meetings at three fully equipped conference rooms in 2180 Milvia. I suspect there is at least one and probably more fully equipped conference rooms in the Planning Department in the building on Center Street. There is equipment with giant display screens at the Fire Department Training Center on Cedar and in Public Works on Allston.

Commissions and the public have been requesting hybrid meetings for months. The excuse has been there isn't equipment. Two days before the Human Welfare and Community Action Commission the Agenda Committee discussed and responded to the recommendations from the Open Government Commission, where Arreguin, Hahn and Wengraf did agree hybrid meetings should be pursued.




