Hi Liza and Epi Team,

The Disability Commission has a couple of questions for the COVID-19 EOC and I'm wondering if we may have some of the data to support:

1. Ethnicity & Disability Statistics of People who have contracted Covid in Berkeley since the beginning of the pandemic.

We do not have consistent, reliable information regarding disabilities among people who have contracted COVID. We do have data on the race/ethnicity of people who have contracted COVID in Berkeley on our public dashboards: https://www.cityofberkeley.info/covid19-data/#demographics

- 2. Utilization rates and accessibility of City of Berkeley Covid testing sites for BIPOC people with disabilities. The COVID testing team would probably have better information to answer this question. The testing data that the epi team has access to in CalREDIE may not include all people who have been tested at COB testing sites. I know that Laura Schroeder had put together a dashboard of the demographics of folks tested by COB testing sites. Janice Chin may have more information on the data behind the dashboard to answer this question.
- 3. Number of BIPOC people with disabilities who have accessed Covid related and/or supportive services since the beginning of the pandemic.

We don't have information on this in our data sources.

4. Vaccinations distribution among seniors and BIPOC communities with disabilities in Berkeley We do not have consistent, reliable information regarding disabilities among people who have been vaccinated for COVID. We do have age and race/ethnicity data for people who have been vaccinated for COVID on our public dashboards:

I am not sure if CAIR, or our vaccine partners keep track of disability status, but wanted to ask just in case we can provide any data. The Commission meets on August 4.
