

Goal

Give homeowners, renters and landlords information about home electrification:

- Health, safety, financial, climate benefits
- Different pathways, options
- Rebates and credits

Home Electrification Fair What we did right

Good team. Good outreach.

Team of 5 selected and engaged with potential presenters, tablers.

Divided outreach tasks: news outlets, allied organizations, flyers at events.

Content overlap of first and third presenters was good. Both early and late arrivers learned about technical and financial aspects, though in different order.

Our host

The David Brower Center provided an ideal venue: tables, auditorium with professional AV support.



Home Electrification Fair What we can do better

Very few people of color

Can more targeted outreach help achieve more diversity?

Program felt crammed

Those who wanted to attend all three presentations had little time to visit tables.

Instead of 2-5 PM 1-5 PM would work better.

Lack of feedback


We prepared an audience survey form but didn't manage to get people to fill them out.

Electrification House Parties

- **Goal:** Give people the confidence to dive in
- Electrified home: Heat pump, heat pump H₂O heater, induction cooking
 - Small scale, ongoing: One home, every two months
 - Neighbor to Neighbor: Personal touch
- Short talk, then tour
 - Switch is On: Info about rebates & contractors
 - Host & Guests: See, touch, listen, ask
 - And snacks!
