- Customer interactions via 311 and website
  - ► 21,538 calls in 2022 (29% of total 311 calls)
  - Zero Waste webpage in Top 10 most visited City pages
- ► EV charging
  - ► Currently one Level 2, 240V dual charging station with one EV sedan
  - Next opportunity for fleet electrification
    - ►One more EV sedan for existing charging station
    - ▶ Purchase of one EV-powered collection vehicle by....?

#### Strategic Plan




- Zero Waste Strategic Plan Status
  - Completed field work on the comprehensive materials characterization study - profiling recycling, organics and refuse streams for residential, commercial, construction debris, and self-haul
  - ► Initiated stakeholder outreach listening sessions with contractors, large generators, business improvement districts, and city council offices
  - Prepared draft online survey

- ▶ SB 1383 Quick Intro Senate Bill to reduce Short-Lived Climate Pollutants
  - Increase edible food recovery capacity to accommodate Tier I and Tier II generator required donation
  - ▶ Purchase 9,341 tons of compost or mulch annually
  - ▶ Provide inspection, technical assistance and enforcement for collection service subscriptions, contamination, food donation
  - Meet extensive record keeping and reporting requirements
  - Conduct quarterly organics samplings
  - Conduct route reviews
  - Replace all containers
- ➤ Staffing: currently hiring for three field representative positions to support 1383 implementation, technical assistance and enforcement. Recruitment scheduled to close May 8, 2023

- AMCS System Integration
  - Integrated software solution: billing, data management, route management, Transfer Station scale system capturing real time data
- Benefits:
  - ▶ Web Based Customer Portal improved customer visibility to account information.
  - Replace PC Scale with Platform Scale, a modern Transfer Station billing and weights management system.
  - ▶ Replace Route Smart with Route Planner a modern routing software that will improve routing efficiencies, route reporting, route management
  - ▶ Improved reporting to local and state government agencies (Stop Waste, CalRecycle)
  - Performance productivity and route metrics
- Updates
  - ▶ Completed Milestone 1 May 2023 data gathering, mapping workflow processes.
  - ▶ Estimated project completion / go-live tentatively scheduled for April May, 2024.

  - ► EIR Complete FY 24
  - ▶ Design Complete FY 27
  - ► Construction Complete FY 29
