





## Overview

### **Deliverable/Recommendation:**

Design and implement a Gun Violence Prevention Program in the City of Berkeley.


**Funding and Timeline:** \$2M (\$1M per FY); July 2024-July 2026

### **Goals/Outcomes:**

- Address Berkeley shootings by developing evidence-based gun violence prevention strategies, drawing insights from successful programs in mid-sized cities across the nation.
- Build a violence intervention ecosystem and network in Berkeley.

Reimagining Public Safety Update to City Council and GVIPP Framework adopted.	<b>Complete</b> January 2024
Request for Proposals (RFP) Process & Contract Finalization with Live Free.	<b>Complete</b> Spring/Summer 2024
Preliminary Implementation Planning and Soft Launch of GVIPP Program. Live Free partners with National Institute for Criminal Justice Reform (NICJR) and the Center for Food, Faith, and Justice (CFFJ) for implementation.	<b>In Progress</b> Summer – Fall 2024

# Gun Violence Intervention and Prevention

## Adopted Framework

### Place Based

- Problem-oriented policing interventions

### Custom Notifications

- Police and CBO deliver deterrence message and offer services

### Street Outreach

- Diffuse conflict, stop retaliation, and urge non-violence

### Social Services

- Wrap-around service plan with case management



# Gun Violence Intervention and Prevention

## Phased Deliverables

### Phase 3: Continued Implementation & Sustainability Efforts

- **Objective:** Ensure long-term integration.
- **Key Actions:** Secure funding, strengthen partnerships, build capacity.
- **Timeline:** Spring 2025-Summer 2026

### Phase 2: Implementation, Data Collection, & Analysis

- **Objective:** Execute and refine program.
- **Key Actions:** Launch interventions, collect data, engage community, provide training.
- **Timeline:** Fall 2024-Summer 2026

### Phase 1: Strategic Program Development for GVIPP

- **Objective:** Establish foundation for GVIPP.
- **Key Actions:** Develop plans, hire staff, form partnerships, set governance.
- **Timeline:** Summer 2024
