



Collision Totals

2024 projections based on data through September 30:

- 843 total collisions projected for 2024 (-3.4% vs 2023)
- 309 non-injury (-14%), 532 injury (+3.5%)
- 4 fatal collisions already recorded*

**2024 totals are through 10/31, fatal total updated through 11/17*

Collisions	2019	2020	2021	2022	2023	2024
Fatal Collisions	4	2	7	2	0	4*
Injury Collisions	520	316	431	548	514	399
Non-Injury Collisions	405	271	351	346	359	232
Total	929	589	789	896	873	632

Traffic Enforcement

Speeding remains the most common primary collision factor.

- "Right of way" (ROW) violations, including "Failure to Yield to Pedestrians in a Crosswalk" combined to account for 133 collisions.
- "Failure to stop" violations combined to account for 51 injury collisions.


Primary Collision Factors

PCF Description	
VC 22350: Unsafe speed for prevailing conditions	150
Other	93
VC 22107: Unsafe turning or moving of vehicle on roadway	88
VC 22106: Unsafe starting or backing of vehicle on highway	50
VC 21453(a): Failure to stop at red light or stop line	48
VC 21950(a): Failure to yield to pedestrian in crosswalk	45
VC 21802(a): Failure to yield when entering through highway	41
VC 21801(a): Failure to yield before left turn or U-turn	32
VC 23152(a): Driving under the influence of alcohol	31
VC 21804(a): Failure to yield to traffic when entering highway	15
